NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the firing and discharge of firearms is hereby prohibited, and declared to be unlawful, in all of that part of Adams County as follows: (Sections 25 and 26, Township 3 South, Range 65 West); (Sections 30 and 31, Township 3 South, Range 64, West); (Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, Township 3 South, Range 63 West) (Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, Township 3 South, Range 62 West)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall not apply to any duly authorized law enforcement officer acting in the line of duty and this resolution shall not be interpreted to prohibit the discharge of any firearms in shooting galleries or in any private grounds or residence under circumstances when such firearm can be discharged in such a manner as to prevent the projectile from any such firearm from traversing any grounds or space outside the limits of such shooting gallery, grounds or residence.
