## Faculty Appointment Guidelines (For Adjunct GDBBS Faculty)

Some GDBBS Programs make provisions for adjunct faculty membership. Individuals seeking adjunct membership in a Program should first consult with the Program Director to determine whether the Program admits adjunct faculty. An individual who currently holds an appointment as a full-time member of a department at an accredited college or university, affiliated institutions or the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention may submit a request for appointment as an adjunct faculty member to a GDBBS Program with which they wish to become affiliated. After consideration by the Program Executive Committee, the Program should forward the request for appointment to the Division office with a recommendation for approval by the GDBBS Director. At a minimum, this request should include:

- The Program Director's approval
- The candidate's request to join the program
- A copy of the candidate's current CV.

Adjunct faculty members have all the rights and privileges of full members, except that they may only serve on University or GDBBS committees in an unofficial capacity and they may only serve as dissertation co-advisors.
