- Your parent(s) (including stepparent) even if you do not live with them. Exclude a parent who has passed away or is not living in the household due to separation or divorce. Include a parent who is on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces.
- Your siblings if they live with your parent(s) (or live apart because of college enrollment), and if your parent(s) will provide more than half of their financial support from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.
- Other people if they now live with your parent(s) and your parent(s) provide more than half of their financial support and will continue to do so through June 30, 2025.

The provided criteria for “dependent children” or “other persons” match the requirement that family size align with whom the parent could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the parent were to file a U.S. tax return at the time of a completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA. As a result, the parent should not include any unborn children in the family size.
