# REGIONAL WATER SPORTS CENTRE, PONG DAM



The Regional Water Sports Centre at Pong Dam was established in 1980, leasing 77 canals of land from the Bhakra Beas Management Board. The facility includes a 100-bed hostel, a guest house, an administrative block, and a boat shed. Throughout the year, the Centre offers a diverse range of water sports courses. Supervised by a Senior Water Sports Instructor, it operates under the Directorate of Mountaineering & Allied Sports in Manali, boasting modern amenities and equipment.

Courses are offered from basic to advanced levels in disciplines of swimming, kayaking, canoeing, rowing, sailing, and water skiing. Additionally, the Centre provides training in water safety and rescue operations.
