

Are you ready to embark on the Talent Operations Programme?

The TOP offers undergraduates the opportunity to study while you work.

Your TOP journey starts when you join our 2024 Internship Programme as a Trainee Manager. From December 2024 and upon graduating from Temasek Polytechnic, candidates who meet the eligibility criteria stated below will be shortlisted to undergo a series of interviews by McDonald's Singapore.

Selected candidates will then undergo a final round of selection and panel interview by SUSS.

Successful candidates will commence their fully-funded four-year SUSS studies in July 2025, while enjoying the security of a Floor Manager position at McDonald's Singapore.

In four years, you will achieve a Bachelor of Science (Bsc) in Business Analytics by SUSS while honing your leadership skills managing your restaurant's business. Throughout your work and study period, candidates will also be eligible to receive an **annual study allowance of up to \$\$3,000** in addition to your pay package.

Upon graduating with your SUSS Business Degree, candidates will secure a 2-year bond with McDonald's Singapore and be in the talent pipeline to become a Business Consultant overseeing a group of McDonald's restaurant.

Eligibility

The Talent Operations Programme (TOP) is an exclusive internship opportunity to select Temasek Polytechnic undergraduates. To be eligible for the TOP, undergraduates must fulfil the following criteria:

- Must be a Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident
- A full-time final year Temasek Polytechnic student
- A minimum GPA score of 3.0 (as of 2023)
