

Seema Aceves, MD PhD

Speaker Biography

Dr. Seema Aceves is a Professor of Pediatrics and Medicine at the University of California, San Diego and Rady Children's Hospital San Diego. She is the Director of the Eosinophilic Gastrointestinal Disorders Clinic at RCHSD and has been the Principal Investigator on multiple clinical and translational research studies on eosinophilic esophagitis (EoE) and non-EoE Eosinophilic Gastrointestinal Disorders (EGIDs). She earned her MD and PhD at UCSD and the Salk Institute as part of the Medical Scientist Training Program. Her NIH funded lab studies the mechanisms and clinical impacts of tissue remodeling in EoE. She has authored more than 130 publications on EoE and EGIDs and is the senior author on the clinical guidelines for EoE including the recently published international consensus recommendation for EoE severity. Dr. Aceves is a co-inventor of oral viscous budesonide, the most common therapy for EoE. She is a member of the American Society for Clinical Investigation and the MRD Endowed Chair in Pediatrics at the University of California, San Diego.
