Jennifer Heimall, MD FAAAAI, FAAAAI, FCIS: Dr. Heimall is the Elizabeth Paige Lavin Endowed Chair of Immunology Research and Clinical Care, fellowship training program director at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and associate professor of clinical pediatrics at Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. She received her MD from New Jersey Medical School, where she also completed her Internal Medicine-Pediatrics residency, followed by fellowship training at NIH. She has held leadership position in the AAAAI Primary Immunodeficiency committee, CIS Executive Council and has recurrently presented at the ACAAI Annual Literature Review Course. She is the PAG liaison for the Primary Immune Deficiency Treatment Consortium and co-lead of PIDTC's current SCID study. She is the clinical director of the CHOP Program for Integrated Immunology and Cellular Therapy. Her clinical research interests include atopic dermatitis and immunodeficiency, newborn SCID and long-term outcomes of hematopoietic stem cell transplant for immunodeficiencies.
