Speaker Biography

Marc Riedl, MD, MS, is Professor of Medicine and Clinical Director of the US HAEA Angioedema Center at the University of California - San Diego (UCSD) where he also serves as Clinical Service Chief for Allergy-Immunology. He received his medical degree from the University of Chicago –Pritzker School of Medicine, completed Internal Medicine residency at Barnes-Jewish Hospital of Washington University in St. Louis, and a Clinical Immunology and Allergy fellowship at UCLA. Dr. Riedl received a Master of Science degree in Clinical Research from UCLA and holds board certifications in Allergy-Immunology and Clinical Pharmacology. He has published over 150 peer-reviewed manuscripts including work in The New England Journal of Medicine, JAMA, and The Lancet. He serves on numerous scientific committees as well as appointed expert panels for the FDA and NIH. Dr. Riedl is a member of Editorial Boards for JACI: In Practice and Allergy and Asthma Proceedings. He serves on the US HAEA Medical Advisory Board, the Immune Deficiency Foundation Physician Advisory Committee, and the Board of Directors for the Western Society of Allergy, Asthma, and Immunology. He directs an active clinical research program at UCSD focused on angioedema and immunodeficiency conditions and lectures frequently at national and international medical conferences.
