

ERC dashboard Quick start guide

5 August 2024



Are you a potential applicant? A host institution? A journalist?
Regardless of your role, you can use the dashboard to get an overview of ERC projects.

The ERC dashboard is a database that allows you to search and export data on ERC-funded projects and evaluated proposals. You can refine your search by researcher, host institution, research domain, funding scheme, country, year, or keyword.

MAIN GUIDANCE

Where can I find the ERC dashboard?

Visit the ERC website and click on the "Projects and Statistics" tab, then select the ERC dashboard. Feel free to bookmark the link for easy access next time.

How to switch between funded projects and proposals?

At the top of the selection screen, you'll find sections for "Funded Projects" and "Evaluated Proposals." These buttons let you switch between viewing signed projects and proposals that passed eligibility checks.

Please note that, due to data regulations, the "Evaluated Proposals" section contains less information than the "Funded Projects" section.

How to filter?


Below, five buttons enable you to filter your search by Grant Type, Country, Domain, Panel, and Year. You can select one or multiple values for each filter.

To validate your selection(s), use ✓, Selections made can be cleared individually or all in one go at the top of the screen.



Your selection is always reflected at the top of the page in boxes, as shown below. Boxes marked with a green bar indicate that a subset of values is selected. The length of the bar indicates the relative size of the current selection. A green bar covering the entire button indicates that all available values have been selected.



1 Once you filter your search, the information displayed below will automatically adapt by giving you key figures and by displaying the list of projects corresponding to your search. Likewise, if you scroll down the page, you can find more information related to your selected variables, such as a project’s abstract, maps or graphs.



How to search for info in the ‘List of funded projects’?

2 In the list of funded projects, you can also filter by using the magnifying glass next to each column.



- “Abstract” column to search for keywords
- “Researcher(s)” column to search researchers’ names
- “Host Institution(s)” column to search a specific host institution

3 Validate your search by clicking on ✓

Please note that for Synergy grants, all researchers' names are listed in the same box, and the same goes for their Host Institutions.

How to export data?




1. Navigate to the right-hand side of the table, map, or graph.
2. Hover over this area until you see the three dots appear.
3. Click on the three dots that appear.
4. From the dropdown menu, choose "Download as."
5. Select "Data" to download the file.
6. The Excel file will be immediately saved to your desktop.



SOME EXAMPLES

I want to know how many projects were funded by the ERC in Italy compared to Spain between 2010 and 2020 (and in which panels).


1. Select Italy and Spain in the “Countries” filter
2. Select the years 2010 to 2020 in the “Year” filter
3. Scroll down to see the data in tables or graphs




I want to look at Sweden's success rate for Advanced Grant calls over the last ten years.

1. Select Sweden in the “Countries” filter
2. Select the years 2014 to 2024 in the “Year” filter
3. Selected Advanced Grants in the “Grant Type” filter
4. Scroll down to see the success rate by call





I want to look at all ERC-funded projects related to 'big data'.

1. Click on the magnifying glass next to the "Abstract" column and type "big data". (Please note that if you search for big data in the abstract section, all projects with the words big or data will be selected. Resolve this issue by adding quotation marks and searching for "big data" instead).
2. Take a look at projects that interests you.

COMMON QUESTIONS

Why can't we see any information regarding the researchers' gender?

The ERC dashboard allows users to filter their searches down to individual projects. However, the ERC cannot display the gender of a specific researcher for a specific project. Our team is currently exploring the possibility of displaying gender figures or percentages for groups of projects.

What about nationality?

We display nationality data only as the number of different nationalities. The actual nationality of individual researchers cannot be shown for privacy reasons.

Would it be possible to create an individual project link that could then be shared?

Unfortunately, the dashboard does not offer this functionality. However, in the list of funded projects, all acronyms are linked to the Cordis database, where you can find detailed information on individual projects.

How often is the database updated?

The database is updated regularly, with the date of the most recent update displayed directly on the sheet.
