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Overview of Order No. 714

Issued on September 19, 2008, Order No. 714, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission revised its regulations to require that, effective October 1, 2010, all tariffs and tariff revisions and rate change applications for the public utilities, natural gas pipelines, oil pipelines and power administrations be filed electronically according to a set of standards developed in conjunction with the North American Energy Standards Board. This rule is part of the Commission's efforts to comply with the Paperwork Reduction Act, the Government Paperwork Elimination Act (GPEA), and the E-Government Act of 2002 by developing the capability to file electronically with the Commission via the Internet.

What is a Tariff?

A Tariff is a compilation of Terms and Conditions of Service, rates and schedules, contracts, and a copy of each form of service agreement, of a particular regular entity, as required by the various statutes and Commission Regulation.

The eTariff Viewer is accessible using Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome or other comparable web browser applications.

eTariff Viewer

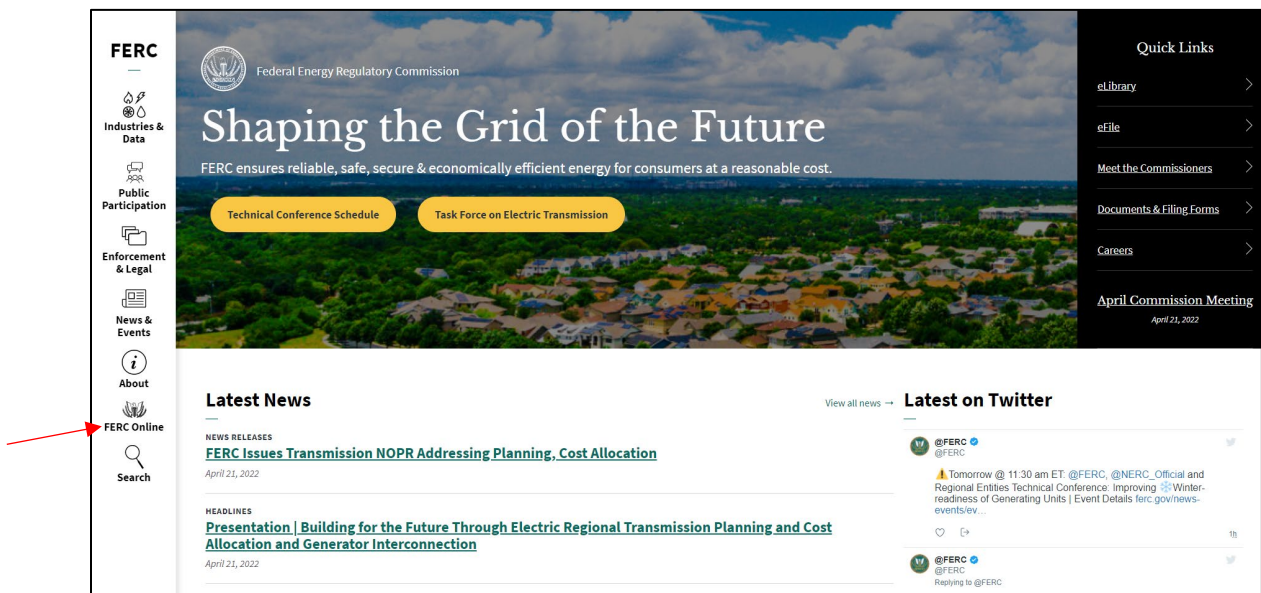


Figure 1 – FERC Web Site

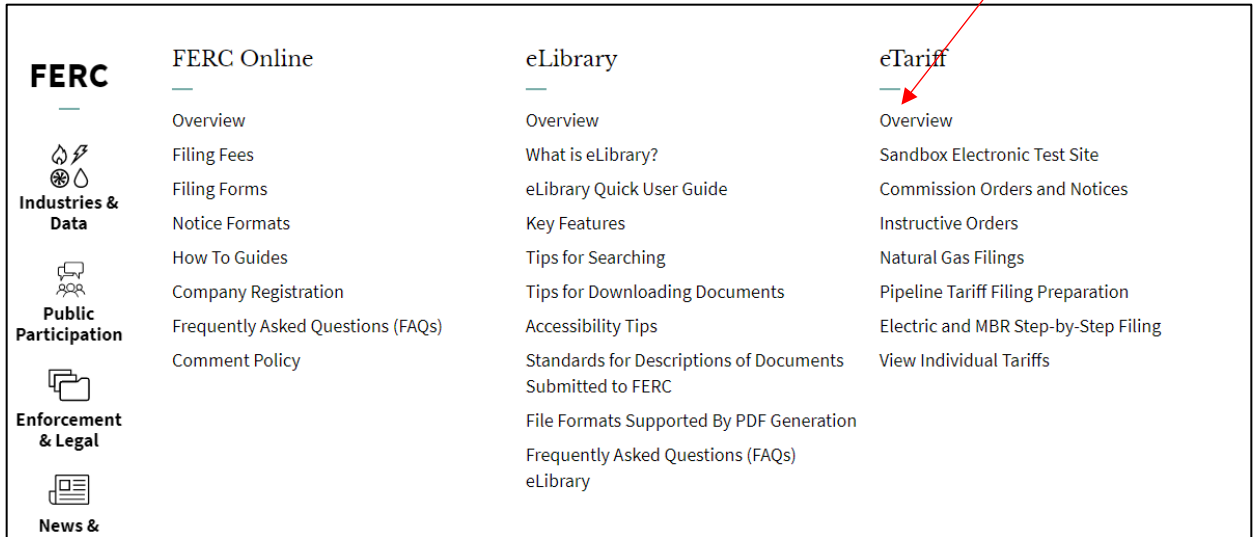


Figure 2 – eTariff Overview Menu

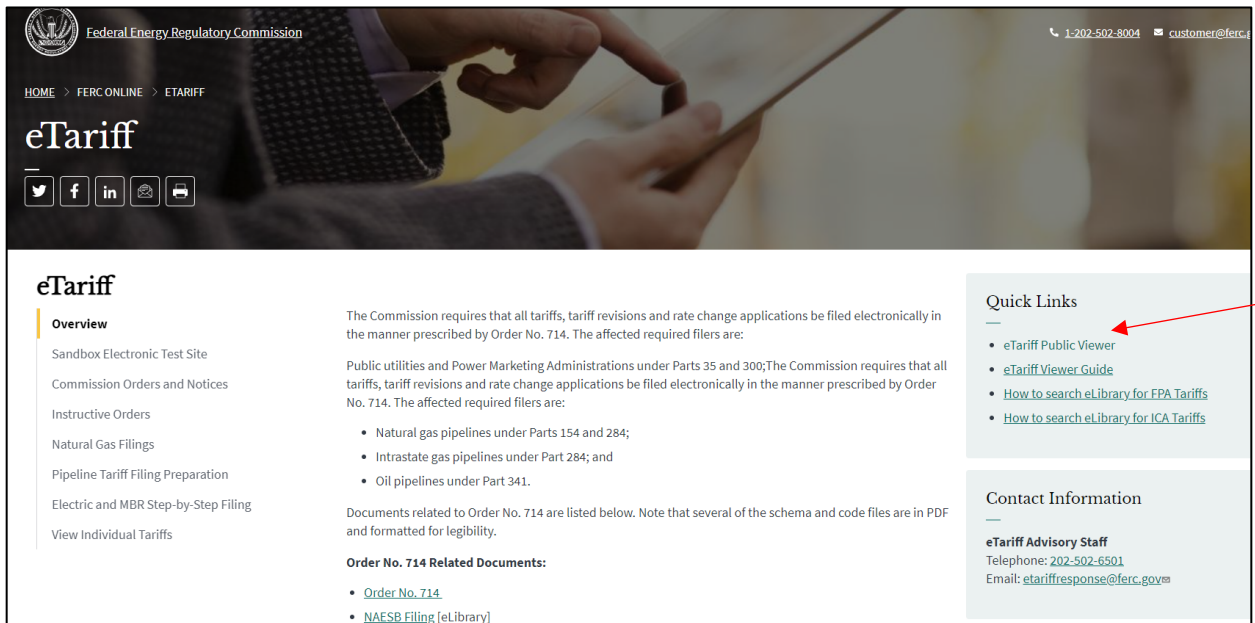


Figure 3 – eTariff Public Viewer Link

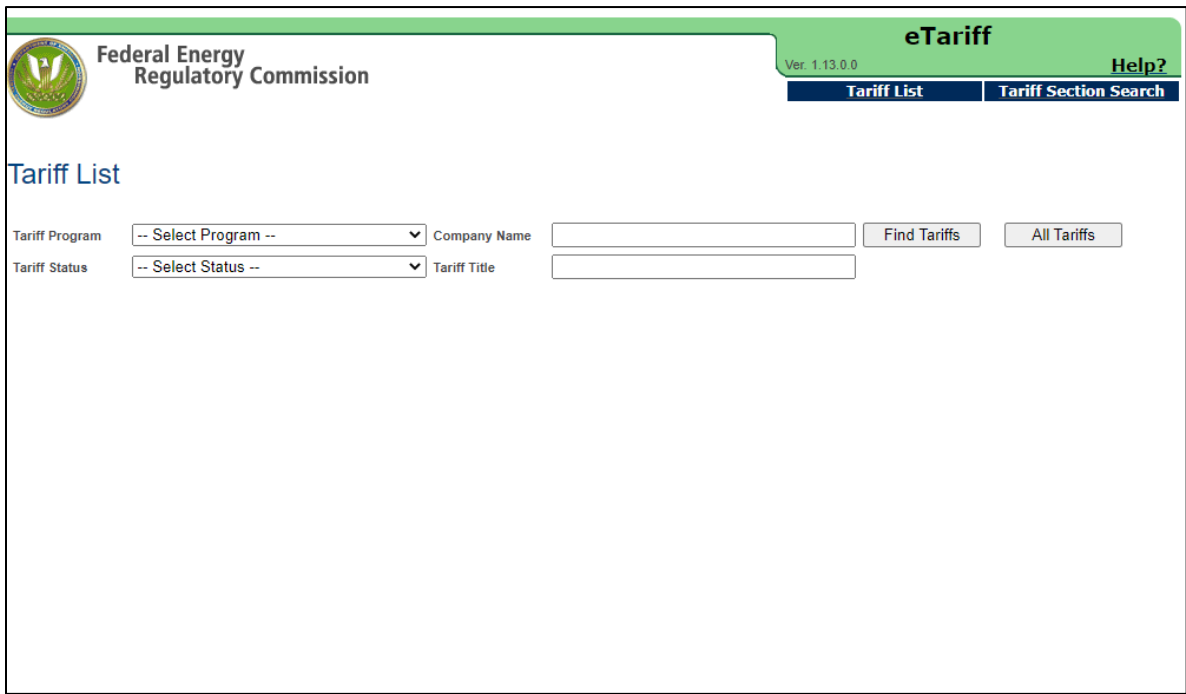


Figure 4 – eTariff Viewer Screen

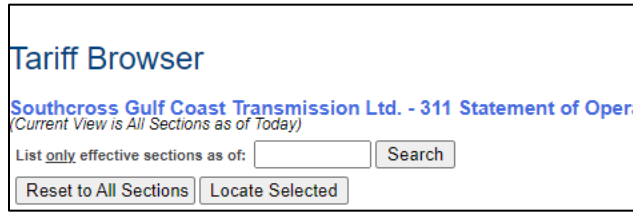


Figure 11 – Select Options

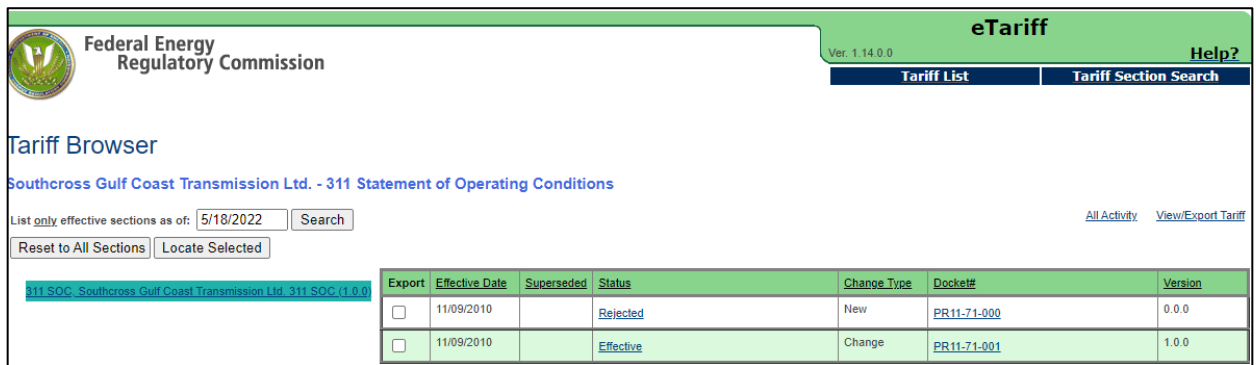


Figure 12 - Sections and History

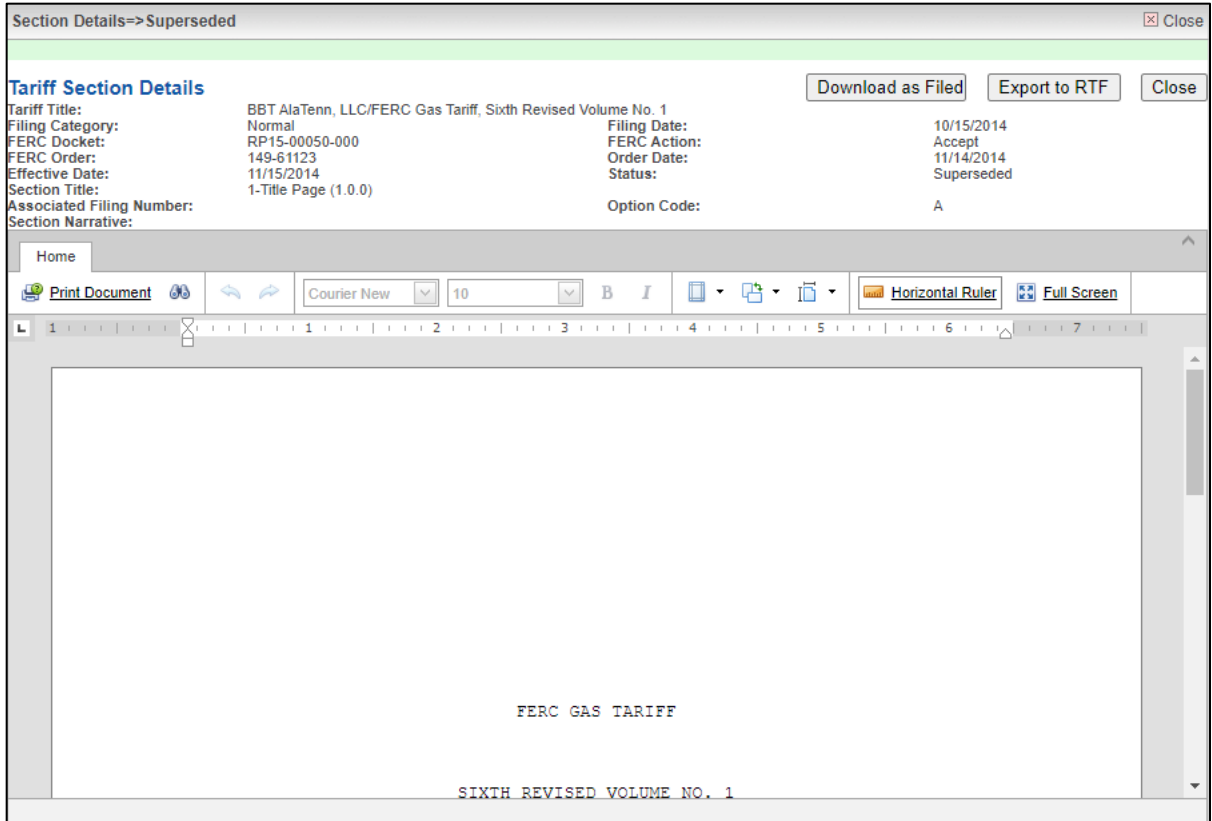


Figure 13 – Tariff Section Details Screen

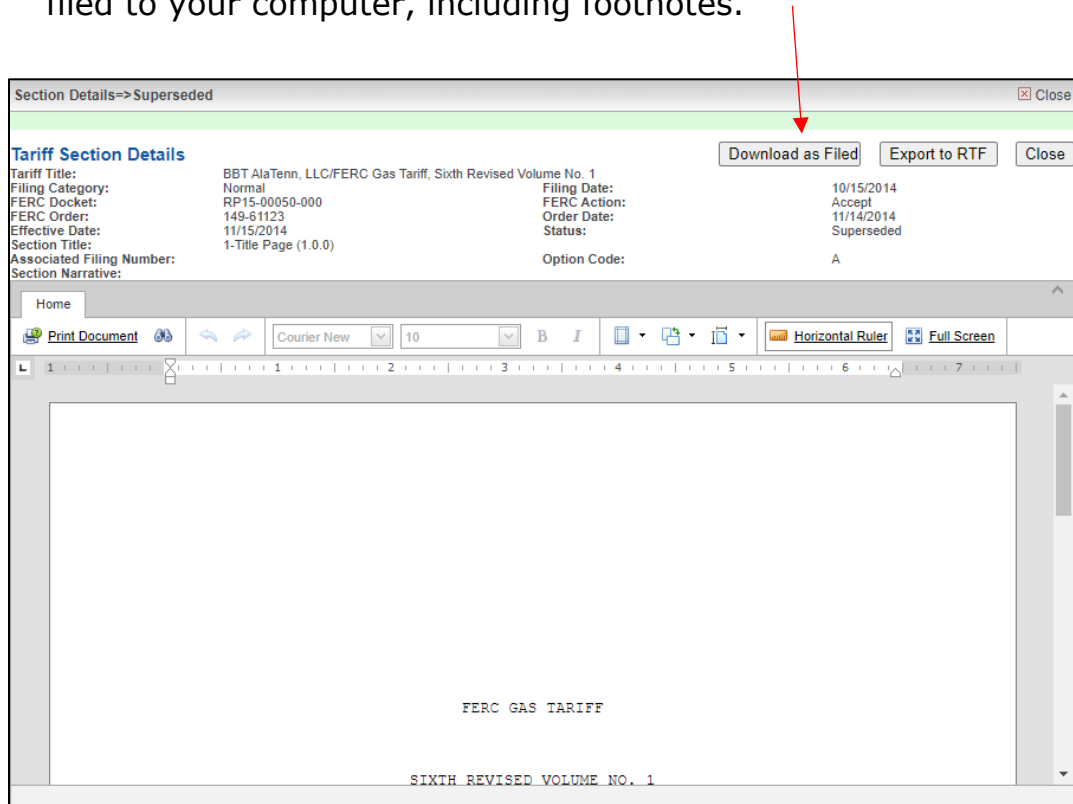


Figure 14 -Download as Filed

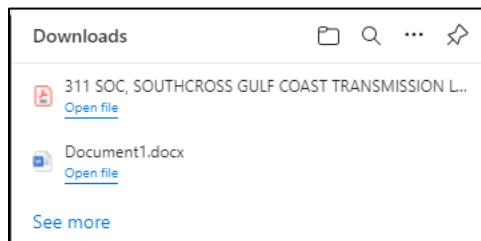


Figure 15 – Open File

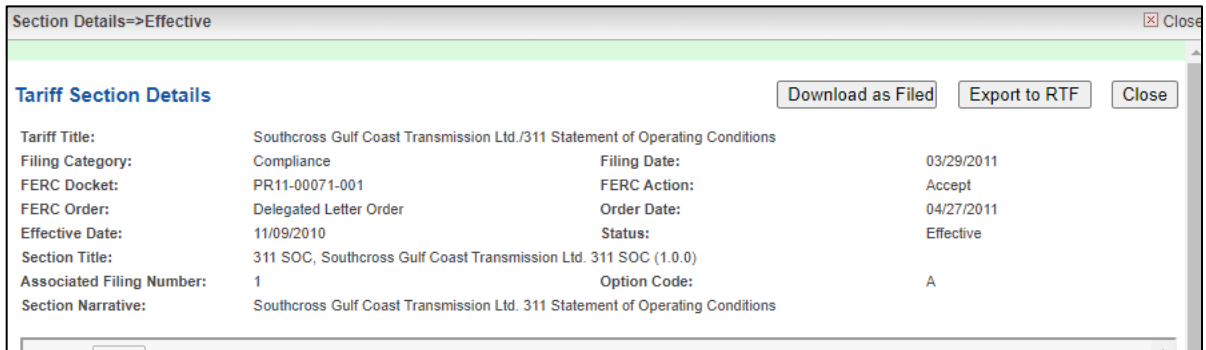


Figure 16 – Export to RTF

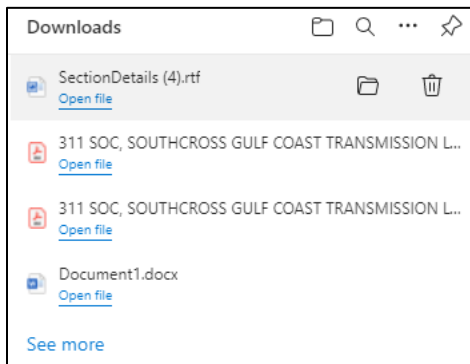


Figure 17 – Open File

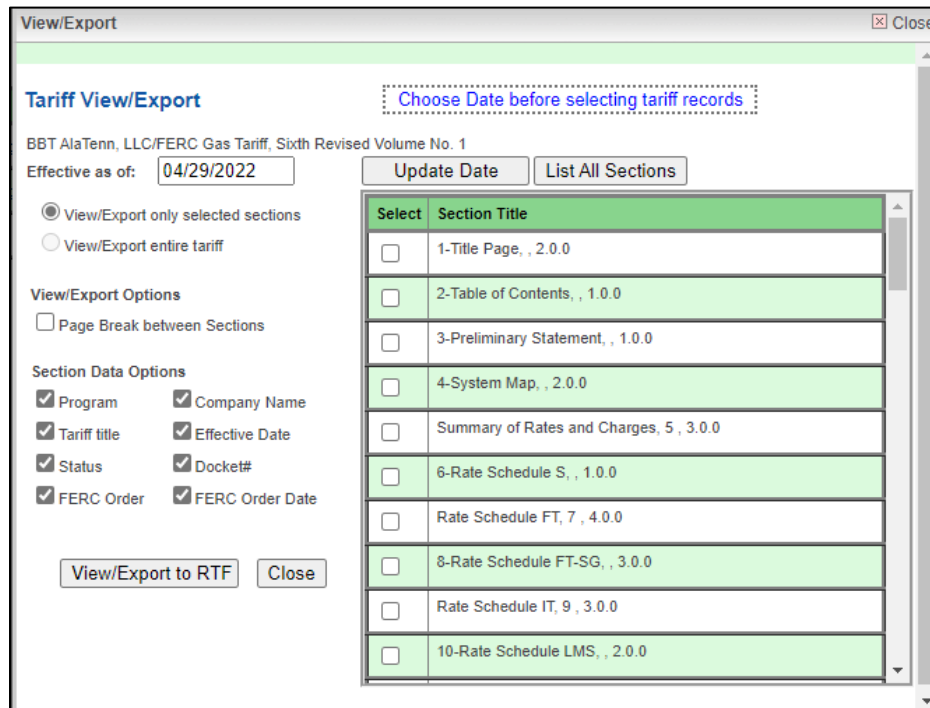


Figure 19 –Export Screen showing View Options

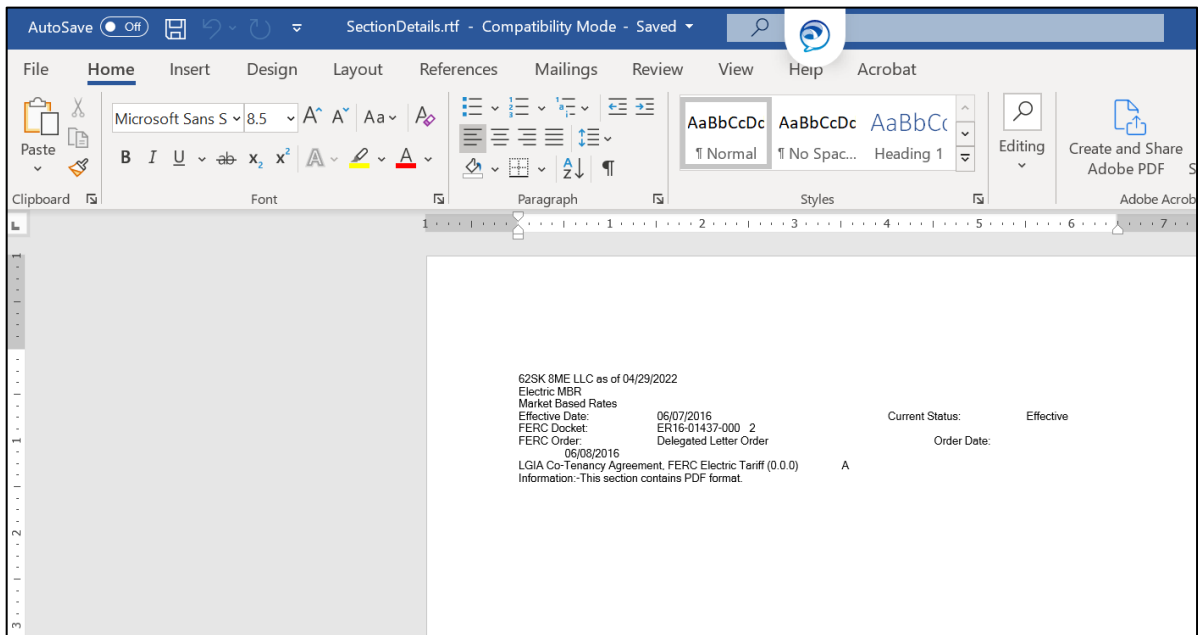


Figure 21 – Downloaded Document

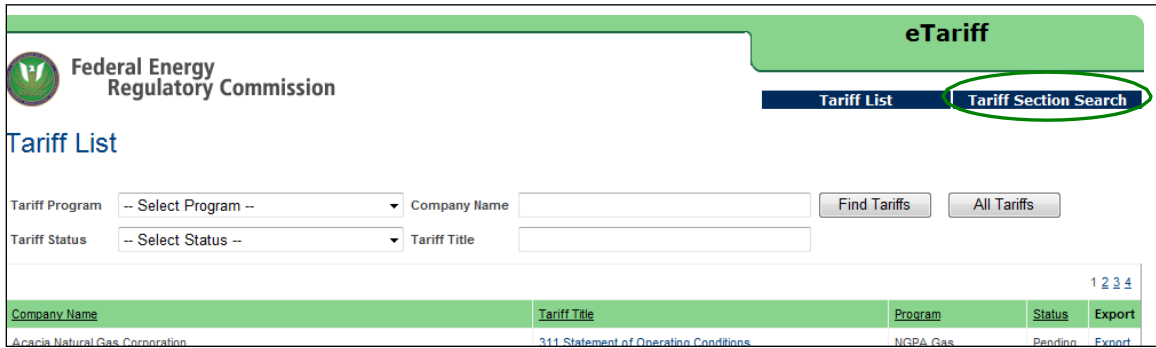



Figure 24- Tariff Section Search Button

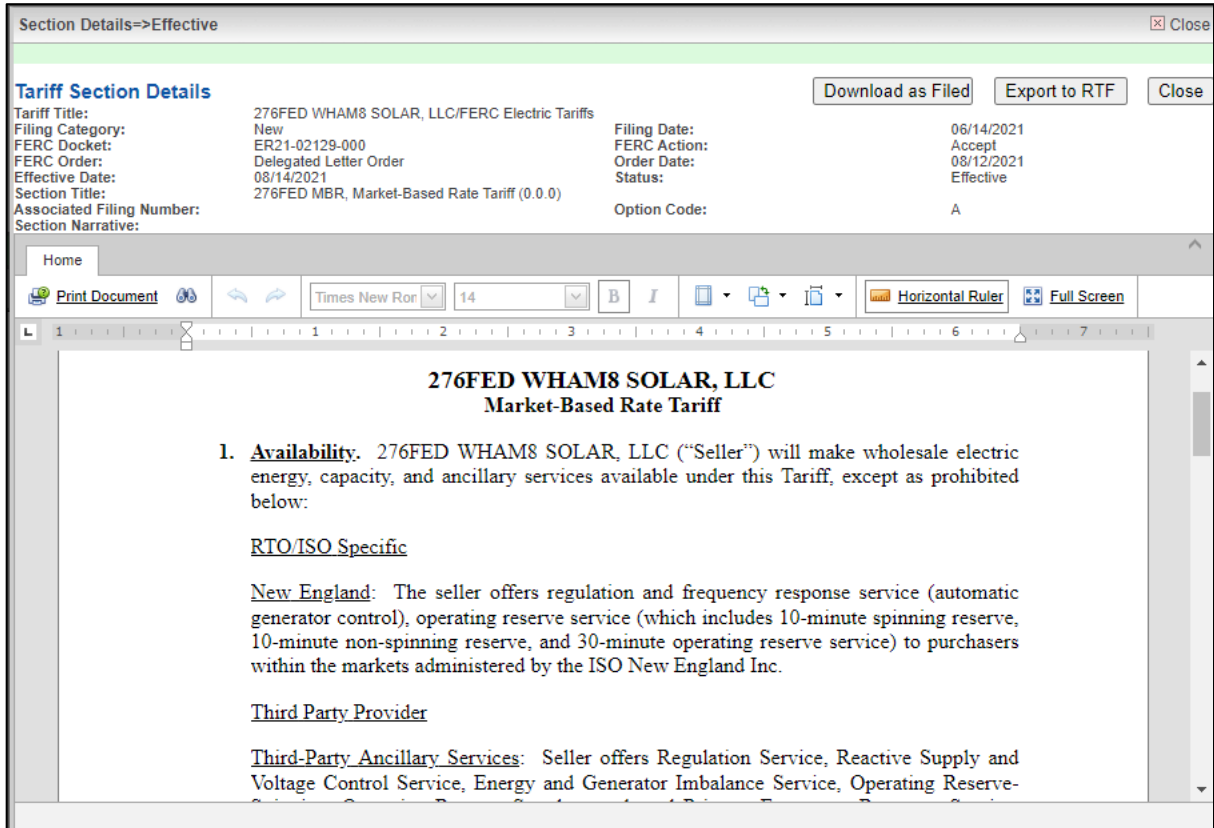


Figure 29 - Tariff Section Details Screen

The Commission provides as a service to the public the ability to download currently effective tariff records of a particular tariff. The purpose of the service is to assist required filers who lose or lose access to their tariff data base to access the Commission’s tariff data base and retrieve enough of their tariff data to continue making valid filings with the Commission. In addition, parties may use this feature to create new tariff data bases or tariff filings. All the data that is provided through this feature is public information and may be found in eLibrary. Please review the disclaimer above and on the Commission’s eTariff Viewer web site.

The XML Column on the Tariff list screen allows viewing of the Tariff Filing XML file.

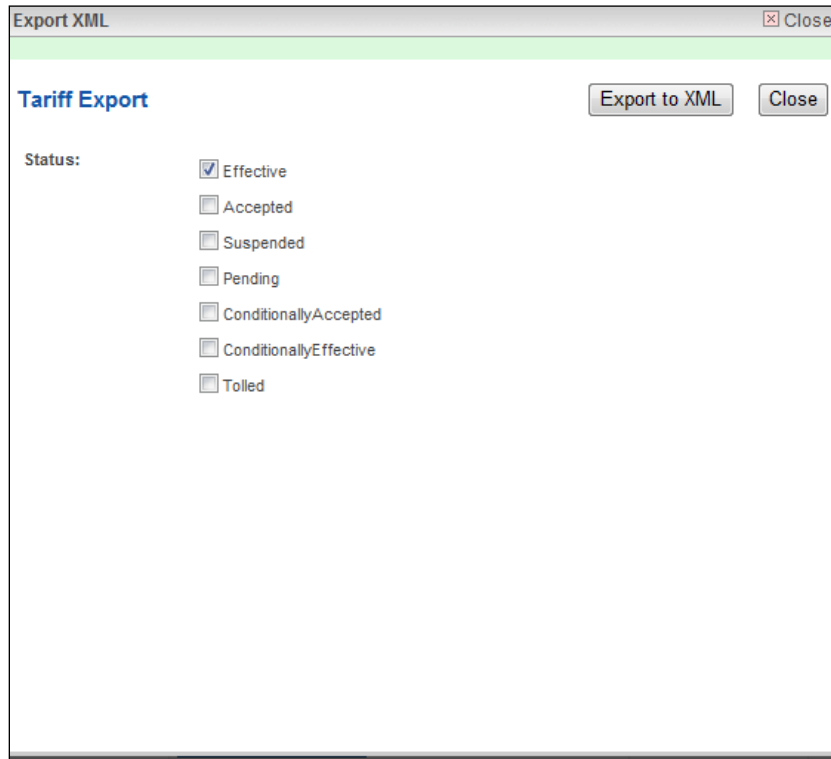


Figure 31 – Export to XML Screen
