AT HOME: The Brewers are 41-26 at home, going 13-6-2 in series play....are 8-2 in their last 10 home games....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks, coming from 5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 40-32 on the road, going 12-9-2 in series play....are 15-7 in their last 22 road games....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks, coming from 4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 37 replay challenges this season, going 23-14....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/2 vs. St. Louis as an out call at first base involving Sal Frelick stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA (26g, 23gs, 12-4, 3.70)

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 34, will be making his 27th appearance and 24th start of the season.....Rea last pitched last Friday at Cincinnati in the first game of the doubleheader and received no decision in the 5-4, 10-inning win (4ip, 6h, 4r, 3er, 0bb, 5k, 2hr, 1hbp, 92 pitches).....he is 10-4 with a 3.86 ERA as a starter (130.2ip, 56er) and 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA in relief (15.1ip, 4er).....the team is 17-6 in his starts.....he has a career-high 8 quality starts.....opponents are batting .238 (134-for-562, 24hr).....he has 10+ wins for the first time in his career.....he has also produced career highs in innings pitched (146.0) and strikeouts (118).....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025.....name is pronounced "RAY."

CAREER: Is 26-18 with a 4.38 ERA in 88 games/72 starts (425ip, 207er).....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24).....is 22-17 with a 4.51 ERA as a starter (383ip, 192er) and 4-1 with a 3.21 ERA in relief (42ip, 15er).....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University.....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.....Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 9-7 with a 4.30 ERA in 28 games/24 starts (142.1ip, 68er).....is 7-3 with a 3.87 ERA in 13 games/12 starts this season (76.2ip, 33er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-7 with a 4.33 ERA in 40 games/30 starts (189ip, 91er).....is 5-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 13 games/11 starts this season (69.1ip, 27er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 1-3 with a 4.35 ERA in 8 games/6 starts (31ip, 34h, 17r, 15er, 15bb, 23k, 6hr), including a no-decision in his only outing this season on 4/21 at Busch Stadium (5ip, 5h, 0r, 3bb, 3k).....Brewers won, 2-0.
