

MIAMI MARLINS (54-91) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (69-76) SEPTEMBER 11, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 12:35 EDT - GAME #146/HOME #75 LHP JONATHAN BERMÜDEZ (0-0, 5.79 ERA) vs. LHP BAILEY FALTER (7-7, 4.45 ERA)

THE PIRATES: earned a series win with their 6-4 win last night against the Marlins... Have won three straight games for the first time since July 28-30... Are 6-3 in their last nine games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 48 one-run games, which are tied for the most in the National League along with the Brewers (the Tigers have played in a Major League-leading 50 one-run games)...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.0 percent) in MLB...Are tied for fifth in MLB with 62 quality starts (Seattle leads with 85)...Are hitting .333 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (.382), Royals (.377), and Reds (.344)... Have the third-highest batting average (.258) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.346) and Arizona (.270)...Have a 5-2-3 (.650) series record against NL East opponents this season, which is their best vs. any division.

CHECKING THE BROOM CLOSET: The Pirates will look to complete their third sweep of the season today...The Pirates swept the Marlins in four games to open the season from March 28-31...Pittsburgh also swept the White Sox in Chicago to close out the first half of the season from July 12-14...Pittsburgh's last three-game sweep of the Marlins in Pittsburgh came from May 25-27, 2015.

ON DECK: The Pirates are off tomorrow but will continue their season-long 10-game homestand with a three-game series against the Royals beginning Friday night...The Pirates are 11-3 all-time against the Royals at PNC Park...Friday will be Kansas City's first visit back to Pittsburgh since a two-game series from April 27-28, 2021.

FISH FRY: The Pirates are 6-0 this season and have won each of their last seven games against the Marlins dating back to the final game of the 2023 campaign on October 1...It's Pittsburgh's longest winning streak against the Marlins since also winning seven in a row from July 7, 2004, to June 1, 2005...Pittsburgh has never won eight games in a row against the Marlins since the team formed in 1993...In addition, the Pirates have never swept a season series of at least seven games against any team since joining the National League in 1887.

SAVING THE DAY: Aroldis Chapman is tied with Francisco Cordero for 17th place all time in career saves (329)...John Wetteland ranks 16th all time with 330 saves...The only three southpaws in MLB history to record more saves than Chapman since saves became an official stat in 1969 are John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422) and Randy Myers (347).

FIRING CUBAN MISSILES: Aroldis Chapman comes into today tied for third in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 91 (Bryan Abreu leads with 97)...Chapman's 91 punchouts are the second-most in a single season by a Pirates left-handed The only Pirates southpaw reliever with more strikeouts in a single season is Rod Scurry (94 in 1982). MOST SEASONS

DENNIS DEALING: Dennis Santana brings the longest active scoreless streak (18.0 innings) in MLB into today...Since June 18, Santana has a 1.27 ERA (35.1ip/Ser), which is the fourth-lowest ERA in all of MLB among relief pitchers with at least 34.0 innings behind Raisel Iglesias (0.00), A.J. Puk (0.25), and Ryan Walker (1.21)...Santana also has an .051 batting average against (3-for-51) in his last 14 appearances.

CUTCH CLUTCH: Andrew McCutchen is one of five active players along with Giancarlo Stanton (13), Paul Goldschmidt (11), Freddie Freeman (11) and Bryce Harper (10) with 10-plus 20-home

run seasons...McCutchen ranks fourth all time in Pirates history with 235 home runs...The only three players with more are Willie Stargell (475), Ralph Kiner (301) and Roberto Clemente (240).

DOWN ON THE FARM: The Professional Baseball Athletic Trainers Society (PBATS) announced that Coleman Duke of the Pirates organization has been named the Florida Complex League's Minor League Athletic Trainer of the Year for the 2024 season...Duke is now eligible for the prestigious Minor League Athletic Trainer of the Year Award, which will be voted on by the full membership of PBATS at the 2024 MLB winter meetings in Dallas, Texas.

STARTING OFF: The 27-year-old lefthander is in his second season with the Pirates after being acquired from the Phillies at the trade deadline last season (August 1) in exchange for infielder Rodolfo Castro...Falter is in his fourth Major League season...He made 50 appearances (24 starts) for the Phillies from 2021-23...He has also made 34 appearances (31 starts) with the Pirates from 2023-24 after being selected in the fifth round of the 2015 draft by Philadelphia.

AGAINST MIAMI: Falter will be making the eighth appearance and fifth start of his career today against the Marlins...He made his 2024 debut against the Marlins on 3/31, allowing six runs in 4.0 innings in a no-decision in the team's 9-7, 10-inning win... Prior to March 31, his previous appearances against the Marlins all came as a member of the Phillies.

LAST TIME OUT: Falter allowed three runs in 5.0 innings while earning his seventh win of the season in his last start on Thursday against the Nationals...He allowed all three of his runs in the first inning.

AND THE WHIFF: Falter had a career-high tying eight strikeouts in his start on August 17 against the Mariners at PNC Park...It was his fourth career eight-strikeout game and second of the season after also punching out eight batters on April 23 against the Brewers at PNC Park.

THIS AND THAT: Falter has a 10-4 career record in 27 career appearances (20 starts) against teams from the National League East...Falter is 2-0 in his last four starts at PNC Park since losing a 5-2 decision against the Mets on July 6.

IN THE BEGINNING: Falter has posted a 7.50 ERA (24.0ip/20er) during the first inning this season...After the first inning he has a 3.70 ERA (97.1ip/40er).

PUTTING UP ZEROES: Falter posted a scoreless streak of 19.2 innings earlier this season from May 12-24...It's the longest scoreless streak of this season by a Pirate.

GETTING HIS WORK IN: Falter has worked 121.1 innings this season, which is a career-high since breaking into the big leagues in 2021...Falter's single-season high for most innings in the minor leagues was 114.1 innings, which came in 2017 while playing for Lakewood in the South Atlantic League.

WHAT THE METRICS SAY: Per Baseball Savant, Falter has an average 7.4 foot extension when releasing the pitch, which ranks in the 98th percentile in Major League Baseball this season...He also ranked in the 99th percentile in 2023 and was in the 100th percentile from 2021-22.
