KANSAS CITY ROYALS (81-67) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (70-77) SEPTEMBER 14, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 1:05 EDT - GAME #148/HOME #77 RHP MICHAEL WACHA (12-7, 3.34 ERA) vs. RHP MITCH KELLER (11-9, 3.85 ERA)

THE PIRATES: had their four-game winning streak come to an end Friday night...Are 7-4 in their last 11 games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have

played in 48 one-run games, which are the second-most in the National League behind the Brewers (49)...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.1 percent) in MLB...Are hitting .333 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (.382), Royals (.367), and Reds (.344)...Have the third-highest batting average (.255) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.339) and Arizona (.267)...Have gone 8-6 against the American League Central (the team's only three remaining interleague games after this weekend will come against the Yankees from September 27-29 on the road).

ABOUT TODAY'S STARTER: Mitch Keller gets the start this afternoon in the middle game of this weekend series against the Royals...Keller allowed two runs in 6.0 innings and was in line for the win in his last start one week ago today in game two of the team's doubleheader against the Nationals (the Nats scored four times in the ninth for the win)...Keller's 2.82 home ERA ranks 13th in all of MLB, including eighth among National League pitchers.

IN SEARCH OF A DOZEN WINS: Mitch Keller comes into today with a team-leading 11 wins...Last year Keller won a career-high 13 games while being named to the All-Star team for the first time in his career...Since 1990, the only three Pirates to win at least 12 games in back-to-back seasons are Denny Neagle (1995-96), Doug Drabek (1990-92) and Kevin Correia (2011-12).

MULTIPLICITY: Bryan Reynolds has doubled twice in back-to-back games (it's the fifth time this season he has collected two doubles in a game)...Reynolds also has multiple hits in each of his last three games, which is the first time for him to accomplish that since having multiple hits in four straight games from July 13-20...Reynolds comes into today ranked fifth among all National League players with 46 multi-hit games, trailing only Luis Arraez (58), Shohei Ohtani (53), Francisco Lindor (50) and Marcell Ozuna (47).

CROWDED NORTH SHORE: Today will be the 28th time that the Pirates have shared the North Shore with either the Steelers or Pitt on the same day in PNC Park history (since 2001)...On August 17, the Steelers hosted the Buffalo Bills in a preseason game after the Pirates played the Mariners at 1:05...In addition to today's 1:05 first pitch against the Royals, the University of Pittsburgh will host West Virginia University at 3:30.

THE MEN BEHIND THE MASK: Yasmani Grandal comes into today ranked second among all active catchers with 172 home runs (the only active catcher in MLB with more is Kansas City's Salvador Perez with 216)...Since the beginning of last month, Grandal is hitting .309 (17-for-55) with three doubles, three home runs, six RBI and a .968 OPS in 17 games.

HIGH FIVE: Oneil Cruz has knocked in a run in each of his last five games, which is tied for the longest active RBI streak in MLB along with Kansas City's Salvador Perez...Cruz is also hitting at a .324 clip (44-for-136) since the beginning of last month, which ranks sixth in all of MLB behind Luis Arraez (.358), Yordan Alvarez (.351), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.348), Aaron Judge (.336) and Bryce Harper (.324).

WHAT TO WATCH FOR: Andrew McCutchen is a .359 career hitter (14-for-39) against Royals starter Michael Wacha...The only three players to collect more hits off Wacha are Anthony Rizzo (22), Joey Votto (17) and Eugenio Suarez (15).

FIRING CUBAN MISSILES: Aroldis Chapman comes into today tied for seventh in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 91 strikeouts (Bryan Abreu leads with 99)... Chapman's 91 punchouts are the second-most in a single season by a Pirates left-handed reliever...The only Pirates southpaw reliever with more strikeouts

PIRATING: Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 20 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 20 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008...Pittsburgh's 85.1 percent stolen-

base success rate leads MLB....Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

in a single season is Rod Scurry (94 in 1982).

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2014 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 28-year-old righthander is in his sixth Major League season... Keller signed a five-year contract extension through the 2028 season on February 22, 2024...The 2023 All-Star has been Pittsburgh's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons, which made him the first Pirate to do so since Francisco Liriano started three straight season openers from 2014-16...He was selected by the Pirates in the second round of the 2014 First Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller was in line for the win (6.0ip/2r) but came away with a no-decision in his last start on September 7 in game two of a doubleheader against the Nationals...He departed with a 4-2 lead before the Nationals scored twice in the seventh and four times in the ninth for an 8-6 win.

ON THE HOME FRONT: Keller has gone 5-3 with a 2.82 ERA (79.2ip/25er) in 13 starts this season at PNC Park (the Pirates are 8-5 in his 13 starts)...Keller's 2.82 home ERA is the eighth-lowest among all National League pitchers...He ranks fifth all-time in PNC Park history in starts (64)...The only four pitchers to have more are Paul Maholm (100), Zach Duke (82), Charlie Morton (66) and Gerrit Cole (65).

SEARCHING FOR A DOZEN WINS: Keller comes into today looking for his 12th win of the season after winning a career-high 13 games in 2023...Since 1990, the only three Pirates to win at least 12 games in back-to-back seasons are Denny Neagle (1995-96), Doug Drabek (1990-92) and Kevin Correia (2011-12).

LEAGUE LEADERS: Keller enters play among the NL leaders in several categories, including tied for seventh in run support (95), tied for 12th in wins (11), 11th in innings pitched (163.2) and 13th in home runs allowed per 9.0 innings (1.10).

AS A STARTER: Keller has made 128 starts as a member of the Pirates since making his big league debut in 2019...Keller's 128 starts are tied for 42nd in team history along with Kip Wells...Cy Blanton, Bob Klinger and Jason Schmidt are tied for 39th in team history with 129 starts.

VS. KANSAS CITY Keller will be making his second career start against the Royals...He lost a 9-6 decision (2.1ip/4r) in his only other start against the Royals on April 28, 2021.

LIMITING THE FREE PASSES: Keller did not issue a walk in 6.0 innings in his last start against the Nationals...lt was the third time in his last four starts that he did not walk a batter...He comes into today ranked 12th in the National League in walks per 9.0 innings (2.31) this season.

AND THE WHIFF: In 2023, Keller set the club record by a right-handed pitcher with 210 strikeouts, surpassing the previous mark of 209 held by A.J. Burnett in 2013.

 Since the beginning of last season, Keller's 363 strikeouts are the fourth-most among all right-handed pitchers in the National League...The only three National League right-handed pitchers to punch out more batters during that time are Zack Wheeler (411), Freddy Peralta (394) and Aaron Nola (376).

SEEING DOUBLE: Keller earned his 10th win of the season on July 8 against the Mets... Last year while being named to the National League All-Star team for the first time in his career, Keller recorded a career-high 13 wins.

 He is the first Pirate to record double-digit win totals in back-to-back seasons since Gerrit Cole, who did so in three straight years from 2013-15.

ON DECK: The 23-year-old Jones will make his 20th career start tomorrow...Allowed two runs in 7.0 innings, struck out nine batters, and won a 7-3 decision in his last start Sunday against the Nationals...Is 1-1 with a 5.19 ERA (17.1ip/10er) in three starts since being reinstated from the injured list on 8/27 (missed 46 games with a right lat strain)...Ranks sixth among all National League rookies in strikeouts (106) and fourth in batting average against (.222).
