MIAMI MARLINS (54-90) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (68-76) SEPTEMBER 10, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #145/HOME #74 RHP ADAM OLLER (1-2, 4.15 ERA) vs. RHP CARMEN MLODZINSKI (2-5, 3.73 ERA)

THE PIRATES: won 3-2 last night in the opener of their three-game series against the Marlins...Are 5-3 in their last eight games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven

frames)...Have played in 48 one-run games, which are the most in the National League (the Tigers have played in a Major League-leading 50 one-run games)...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.7 percent) in MLB...Are fifth in MLB with 62 quality starts (Seattle leads with 85)...Are hitting .333 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (.382), Royals (.377), and Reds (.344)...Have the third-highest batting average (.258) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.346) and Arizona (.272)..Have a 4-2-3 (.611) series record against NL East opponents this season, which is their best vs. any division...The only National League team with a better series record against the NL East this season is Atlanta (7-4-2, .615).

FISH FRY: The Pirates are 5-0 this season and have won each of their last six games against the Marlins dating back to the final game of the 2023 campaign on October 1 here at PNC Park... It's Pittsburgh's longest winning streak against the Marlins since also winning six in a row from August 6, 2014, to August 24, 2015...The last time the Pirates won more than six straight games against the Marlins was from July 7, 2004, to June 1, 2005 (seven in a row).

RUN-PRODUCING REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds has knocked in a run in three straight and four of his last five games...Reynolds is tied for seventh in all of MLB among primary outfielders with 82 RBI...The only six primary outfielders with more RBI are Aaron Judge (126), Juan Soto (98), Anthony Santander (94), Teoscar Hernandez (87), Spencer Steer (86) and Jackson Merrill (83).

SAVING THE DAY: Aroldis Chapman moved into sole possession of 18th all-time with his 328th career save last night (he was tied with Fernando Rodney)...Chapman's next save will tie him with Francisco Cordero for 17th place (329)...The only three southpaws in MLB history to record saves than Chapman (since saves became an official stat in 1969) are John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422) and Randy Myers (347).

FIRING CUBAN MISSILES: Aroldis Chapman comes into today seventh in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 89 strikeouts... Chapman's 89 punchouts are tied for the third-most in a single season by a Pirates left-handed reliever along with Felipe Vazquez in 2018...The only two Pirates southpaw relievers with more strikeouts in a single season are

DENNIS DEALING: Dennis Santana brings the longest active scoreless streak (17.0 innings) in the National League into today (Tampa Bay's Kevin Kelly has MLB's longest streak at 17.1 innings)...Since June 18, Santana has a 1.31 ERA (34.1ip/5er), which is the fifth-lowest ERA in all of MLB among relief pitchers with at least 34.0 innings behind Raisel Iglesias (0.00), A.J. Puk (0.26), Tanner Scott (1.04) and Ryan Walker (1.27)...Santana also has an .043 batting average against (2-for-47) in his last 13 appearances.

KEEPING GOOD COMPANY: Oneil Cruz connected for his 19th home run of the season in Monday's win against the Marlins...Since the beginning of August, Cruz ranks fifth in all of MLB with a .336 batting average...The only four players with a higher average during that time are Yordan Alvarez (.362), Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.357), Aaron Judge (.342) and Luis Arraez (.341).

Rod Scurry (94 in 1982) and Felipe Vazquez (90 in 2019).

20-20 VISION: Andrew McCutchen hit his 19th home run of the season on Sunday...His next homer would mark his eighth career 20-home run season with the Pirates, which would break a tie with Ralph Kiner for the second-most 20-home run seasons in Pirates history behind only Willie Stargell (15).

NICK WITH THE STICK: Nick Gonzales is hitting .321 (17-for-53) in 13 games since being reinstated from the injured list on August 26...That's tied for the seventh-most hits in the National League during that time (Luis Arraez leads the way with 23)...Gonzales leads the Pirates with nine game-winning RBI this season.

HOW ACQUIRED: Pittsburgh's Comp A Selection (31st Overall) of the 2020 Draft.

STARTING OFF: Last name is pronounced ma-JINSK-ee...The 25-year-old righthander is in his second with the Pirates...Entering today, he's made 66 career appearances (four starts) for the Bucs, including 31 relief appearances and three starts in 2024... He began the 2024 season on the injured list with right elbow inflammation and was optioned to Triple-A Indianapolis after being activated on April 10...He was also placed on the injured list with a right shoulder strain on July 30 before being activated on August 27...Mlodzinski was selected as the team's Comp A selection (31st overall pick) in the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.

AS A STARTER: Tonight will be Mlodzinski's fifth career Major League start and his fourth of the season, having served as an "opener" previously on June 21, 2024 vs. Tampa Bay (1.2ip/1r), June 14, 2024 at Colorado (1.0ip/0er), June 8, 2024 vs. Minnesota (1.2ip/0r) and July 9, 2023 at Arizona (1.1ip/1r/0er).

 Carmen spent his first two professional seasons as a starter from 2021-22, making 36 starts in that time between High-A Greensboro and Double-A Altoona...He also started 14 of 26 games during his collegiate career at the University of South Carolina from 2018-20.

LAST TIME OUT: Mlodzinksi allowed one run on two hits in 1.0 inning of work on Sunday in the team's 7-3 win against the Nationals.

VS. MIAMI: Mlodzinski will be making his first start and fourth appearance against the Marlins tonight...His most recent outing against Miami came on September 29 of last season when he tossed 0.2 scoreless inning here at PNC Park.

CARMEN'S ELECTRIC: Mlodzinski has recorded a 2.63 ERA (24.0ip/7er) in 19 appearances dating back to June 16...He also has a 2.43 ERA (33.1ip/9er) in 26 appearances (three starts) dating back to June 2.

SAVING THE DAY: Mlodzinski has one save in his big league career, which came on September 23 of last season at Cincinnati...The Pirates rallied from being down 9-0 after three innings at Cincinnati by staging their largest come-from-behind win in their 137 seasons of play in the National League.

2023 RECAP: Mlodzinski reached the Big Leagues for the first time last season, making his Major League debut on June 16 at Milwaukee...In total, he appeared in 35 games (one start), posting a 3-3 record with 11 holds, 1 save, 2.25 ERA (36.0ip/9er), 34 strikeouts and 18 walks...Twenty four of his outings were scoreless.

- Posted a 1.88 ERA (5 ER in 24.0 IP) over his last 24 appearances, dating back to July 18...Made a team-high 14 appearances during the month of September/ October and posted a 2.19 ERA (3 ER in 12.1 IP).
- Earned his first career win on June 30 vs. Milwaukee.

AS A PROSPECT: Entered the 2021 season ranked by MLB Pipeline as Pittsburgh's 10th-best prospect...Was rated by MLB Pipeline as having the "Best Changeup" in the Pirates minor league system at the end of the 2020 season.
