PITTSBURGH PIRATES (63-73) vs. CHICAGO CUBS (71-66)

SEPTEMBER 2, 2024 AT WRIGLEY FIELD, CHICAGO, IL - 6:40 CDT - GAME #137/ROAD #69

RHP JARED JONES (5-7, 3.88 ERA) vs. RHP JAMESON TAILLON (9-8, 3.85 ERA)

THE PIRATES: lost 6-1 yesterday in the deciding game of their weekend series against the Guardians...Have 10 shutouts this season, which are the sixth-most in the National League (Philadelphia leads the way with 14)...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have played in 47 one-run games, which are the most in MLB (played 39 one-run games in all of 2023)...Have the best stolen base percentage (86.8 percent) in MLB... Are tied for sixth in MLB with 58 quality starts (Seattle leads with 81)...Are hitting .340 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Royals (.384) Diamondbacks (.375) and Reds (.353)...Have the fourth-highest batting average (.239) in MLB in pinch-hit situations...Have scored the fifth-most runs (54) in MLB since August 22 behind the Cubs (99), Diamondbacks (65), Brewers (65) and Tigers (55)...Have gone 22-22 in series openers, including 9-13 on the road.

STREAKING CATCH: Andrew McCutchen brings a season-high 13-game hitting streak into today, which is tied for the longest active streak in MLB along with Carlos Correa...McCutchen has gone 17-for-51 (.333) with two doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.034 OPS during his current 13-game hitting streak... McCutchen's last single-season hitting streak of more than 13 games came in 2015 when he hit safely in a career-high 18 straight games with the Pirates... McCutchen has also reached base safely in 14 straight games, which is tied for the third-longest active streak in MLB behind Francisco Lindor (30 games) and Yordan Alvarez (25 games).

BACK AT THE FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Pirates return to Wrigley Field tonight for the first time since winning three of four games from May 16-19...Pittsburgh's pitching staff recorded a 2.29 ERA (35.1p/9er) in that series, including a 1.75 ERA (25.2ip/5er) by the starting rotation...The Pirates have won their last two series at Wrigley Field for the first time since 2017...The last time the Pirates won three straight on the road against the Cubs was a four-series streak spanning 2013 and 2014...Courtesy of StatsPerform.

A CALL TO ARMS: Jared Jones comes into today ranked seventh among all National League rookies with 102 strikeouts...Jones and Paul Skenes (136) are the second rookie duo in Pirates history with at least 100 strikeouts...The other was in 1993 when Steve Cooke had 132 strikeouts while Paul Wagner had 114 punchouts.

CONNOR AND THE CUBS: Connor Joe has four home runs against the Cubs this year...It's the first time in his career hitting more than two home runs against a single opponent in a season...The only Pirates this century with more home runs in a season against the Cubs were Brian Giles in 2002 (seven) and Starling Marte in 2019 (five).

AUGUST AND EVERYTHING AFTER: Oneil Cruz ranks first in the National League and third in all of MLB with a .374 average since the beginning of last month...The only two players with a higher average since the beginning of August are Yordan Alvarez (.387) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.375)...Cruz is also fifth in MLB with a .432 OBP since the beginning of August...The only four players with a higher OBP are Aaron Judge (.516), Yordan Alvarez (.482), Joc Pederson (.467) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.454).

PIRATING: Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 18 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 18 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008... Pittsburgh has stolen a base in each of its last seven games and has 18 steals in its last 12 games...The last time a Pirates runner was caught stealing was on August 7...Pittsburgh's 86.8 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB...Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

LET'S GO REYNOLDS: Bryan Reynolds enters today's action sixth in the National League in hits (149), 11th in batting (.282) and 12th in on-base percentage (.349)...He recorded the 800th hit of his career yesterday afternoon and comes into today three RBI shy of 400...Reynolds' 800 hits since the beginning of the 2019 season are the 15th-most in MLB (Freddie Freeman is first with 971).

TODAY'S STARTER **RHP JARED JONES** **#37**

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected by the Pirates in the 2nd round of the 2020 Draft.

STARTING OFF: The 23-year-old righthander is in his first Major League season with the Pirates...Was named to the Opening Day roster after being a non-roster invitee to big league camp...The Whittier, California, native was Pittsburgh's second-round draft selection in 2020 out of La Mirada (CA) High School.

LAST TIME OUT: Allowed five runs in 4.0 innings while losing a 9-5 decision against the Cubs on Tuesday at PNC Park.

VS. CHICAGO (NL): Has gone 1-2 in three starts...In addition to his last start on Tuesday, he lost a 7-2 decision (6.0ip/3r/2er) at PNC Park on 5/10...He also won a 5-4 decision (6.0ip/3er) at Wrigley Field on May 16.

FAMILIAR FOE: Tonight is Jared Jones' fourth start of the season against the Cubs...The only other pitcher to make four starts this year against the Cubs is Miles Mikolas.

AS A PROSPECT: Jones entered the 2024 season rated as the team's No. 3 prospect and the No. 74 prospect in all of baseball according to Baseball America.

FEELING BETTER NOW: Jones was placed on the 15-day injured list on July 4 with a right lat strain...He made a total of three rehab starts with Triple-A Indianapolis, where he went 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (11.0ip/6er)...In his last rehab start on August 20 at Columbus, he threw a total of 73 pitches (53 strikes) while striking out 10 of the 16 batters that he faced.

THE CENTURY MARK: Jones has amassed 102 strikeouts so far this season...Since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893, the only other three Pirates to reach 100 career strikeouts in fewer in 20 games are Gerrit Cole in 2013 (19), Jose DeLeon in 1983 (13) and Paul Skenes (13).

BODY OF WORK: Is making his 18th career start and appearance tonight...He has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 14 of his 17 starts, as well as two or fewer nine times and one or fewer five times.

ON THE ROAD: Jones will look to snap a two-game road losing streak tonight...He has allowed a combined 13 runs in 9.0 innings in those two starts...His last win on the road came here at Wrigley Field on May 16.

WHAT A DEBUT: Jones became the first Pirate since Tim Wakefield in 1992 and the third pitcher in team history to record at least 10 strikeouts in his big league debut on March 30 at Miami...In addition, he became one of just five starting pitchers since 1900 to strike out at least 10 batters in less than 6.0 innings in a big league debut...Prior to Jones, Milwaukee's Freddy Peralta was the last pitcher to record 10-plus strikeouts in a big league debut when he did so on May 13, 2018 (13 punchouts)... Dick Hall struck out 11 batters in his first MLB start, but he made his MLB debut as a third baseman for the Pirates on April 15, 1952.

NO WALK SIGN IS ON: Jones opened his career with a streak of 21.1 consecutive innings without issuing a walk before allowing his free pass to Blake Perkins in the fifth inning on April 22 vs. Milwaukee...It was the fifth-longest streak by a Major League pitcher within their first five career games since 1971 and the longest since Cleveland's Cody Anderson had a streak of 25.2 consecutive innings without allowing a walk in 2015.

DOWN ON THE FARM: In 2023 Jones finished tied for the organizational lead in strikeouts (146) along with Thomas Harrington (his 3.85 ERA was also the third-lowest among Pirates farmhands with at least 90.0 innings pitched last year)...He entered the 2023 season rated as the organization's No. 11 prospect according to Baseball America while attending big league camp for the first time in his career.

ON DECK: The 22-year-old Skenes will be making his 19th start tomorrow...Allowed three runs (2er) in 5.0 innings but had a no-decision in the team's 14-10 loss Wednesday against the Cubs...Has posted the lowest ERA (2.23) in all of MLB since making his debut on 5/11...Will be facing the Cubs for the fourth time after making his debut against them on 5/11 while also earning his first career win against them on 5/17 at Wrigley Field.
