## KANSAS CITY ROYALS (80-67) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (70-76)

SEPTEMBER 13, 2024 AT PNC PARK, PITTSBURGH, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #147/HOME #76

RHP ALEC MARSH (7-8, 4.66 ERA) vs. RHP LUIS ORTIZ (6-5, 3.26 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:** had the day off yesterday...Have won four straight games for the first time since winning a season-high six straight games from July 11-20...Are 7-3 in their last 10 games...Have won 15 games in their last at-bat (their most since having 16 last at-bat wins in 2021)...Have won eight games when trailing after seven innings (their most since winning nine times in 2019 when trailing after seven frames)...Have played in 48 one-run games, which are tied for the most in the National League along with the Brewers (the Tigers have played in a Major League-leading 50 one-run games)...Have the best stolen base percentage (85.1 percent) in MLB...Are tied for fifth in MLB with 63 quality starts (Seattle leads with 87)...Are hitting .333 with the bases loaded; the fourth-highest average in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (.382), Royals (.367), and Reds (.337)... Have the third-highest batting average (.258) in MLB in pinch-hit situations behind Baltimore (.346) and Arizona (.267)...Are tied for the third-best record (7-4) in MLB this month...The only two teams with a better record are the Mets and Phillies at 8-2 apiece.

**COMING INTO HIS OWN:** Luis Ortiz gets the start tonight in the opener of this weekend series against the Royals...Ortiz has recorded a 3.14 ERA (71.2ip/25er) since June 26 when he made his first start of the season...Ortiz' 3.14 ERA during that time ranks 14th in MLB and seventh among all National League pitchers...The only six National League pitchers to record a lower ERA since June 26 are Chris Sale (1.80), teammate Paul Skenes (2.08), Zack Wheeler (2.45), Sean Manaea (2.72), David Peterson (2.74 and Shota Imanaga (3.10).

**ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER:** Luis Ortiz has allowed just 6.33 hits per 9.00 innings in 12 starts this season...According to StatsPerform, that is on track to be the best mark by a Pirates starter since Jose DeLeon (6.25 hits per 9.0 innings) in 1983 (minimum 50.0 innings).

**FOR STARTERS:** Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 2.54 ERA (39.0ip/11er) in the last seven games dating back to September 5...That's the eighth-lowest ERA in all of MLB behind the Reds (0.92), Royals (1.75), Yankees (1.89), Blue Jays (1.91), Red Sox (2.27), Braves (2.39) and Mets (2.43).

**SETTING UP THE SERIES:** The Pirates are 11-3 all-time against the Royals at PNC Park...Tonight will be Kansas City's first visit back to Pittsburgh since a two-game series from April 27-28, 2021...Pittsburgh has held Kansas City to three or fewer runs in 11 of the 14 meetings at the ballpark.

**IN THE BOX:** The Pirates have struck out six or fewer times in four straight games while winning each game...That is tied for the longest such streak by any team this season, and the longest by the Pirates since doing so in six straight games in July of 2017.

**SAVING THE DAY:** Aroldis Chapman is tied with Francisco Cordero for 17th place all time in career saves (329)...John Wetteland ranks 16th all time with 330 saves...The only three southpaws in MLB history to record more saves than Chapman since saves became an official stat in 1969 are John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422) and Randy Myers (347).

**FIRING CUBAN MISSILES:** Aroldis Chapman comes into today tied for sixth in all of MLB among relief pitchers with 91 strikeouts (Bryan Abreu leads with 97)...Chapman's 91 punchouts are the second-most in a single season by a Pirates left-handed reliever...The only Pirates southpaw reliever with more strikeouts in a single season is Rod Scurry (94 in 1982).

**GOING THE EXTRA MILE:** Bryan Reynolds doubled twice on Wednesday, giving him 300 career extra base hits (he surpassed Pirates Hall of Famer Manny Sanguillen for 36th in team history)...Since the beginning of the 2019 season, Reynolds ranks 11th among all National League players in extra base hits (Freddie Freeman leads the way with 383).

**PIRATING:** Oneil Cruz has been successful in each of his last 20 attempts since being caught for the only time on April 22...The last Pirate to steal at least 20 consecutive bases without being caught in a single season is Nate McLouth (21 straight) from May 2 to September 28, 2008...Pittsburgh's 85.1 percent stolen-base success rate leads MLB...Since 1951, the only seasons in which Pittsburgh led MLB in that category are 1979 and 1997.

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

September 13, 2017: Andrew McCutchen became just the fourth Pirate in team history to hit 200 home runs after connecting for his 25th of the season and his second in two games at Milwaukee's Miller Park. McCutchen joined Willie Stargell (475), Ralph Kiner (301) and Roberto Clemente (240) as the only players in club history with at least 200 home runs.

**HOW ACQUIRED:** Signed by Pittsburgh as a non-drafted free agent on Oct. 2, 2018

**STARTING OFF:** The 25-year-old righthander is in his third Major League season, which have all come as a member of the Pirates...He has made 56 career appearances (31 starts) for the Bucs, including 22 relief appearances in 2024 (12 starts)...He made the first Opening Day roster of his career with the Pirates in 2024 after making just two appearances (both starts) with the club in 2022 and 18 appearances (15 starts) over two stints with the Bucs in 2023...Ortiz was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent on October 2, 2018.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Ortiz allowed four runs (3er) in 5.2 innings while losing a 5-3 decision in game one of Saturday's doubleheader against the Nationals.

**VS. KANSAS CITY:** Ortiz will make his second career appearance (first start) against the Royals...He allowed one run on three hits in 5.0 innings of relief in the team's 6-3 win last year at Kauffman Stadium on August 29.

**STARTING OFF:** Ortiz has posted a 3-3 record with a 3.10 ERA (69.2ip/24er), 50 strikeouts and .198 batting average against as a starter this season.

- Dating back to his final start of the 2023 season until July 20, 2024, Ortiz threw 5.0-plus innings and allowed four or fewer hits in five consecutive starts, matching the second-longest such streak in club history...The only longer streak was six, accomplished by Francisco Liriano from July 17-Aug. 14, 2014.
- He threw at least 5.0 innings, allowed five or fewer baserunners and one or zero runs in each of his first four starts this season...That tied Cliff Lee (2008), Trevor Bauer (2020), Corbin Burnes (2021) and Carlos Rodon (2022) for the longest streak of such starts to begin a season in the modern era (since 1901).

**ZERO TOLERANCE:** Ortiz had his career-best scoreless streak of 16.0 innings end in his last start...It's the third-longest by a Pirate this season...Bailey Falter had a team-best scoreless streak of 19.2 innings from May 12-24 while Dennis Santana also has a scoreless streak of 18.0 innings, which is currently the second-longest active streak in MLB...Ortiz also had a scoreless streak of 12.0 innings earlier this year from July 2-13.

**FOR STARTERS:** Today will be Ortiz' 32nd career Major League start and his 13th of the season.

- Served in the bulk role following Carmen Mldozinski "opening" for the Bucs three times this season...Ortiz threw 4.1 shutout frames on June 8 vs. Minnesota, allowed one run in 5.0 innings on June 14 at Colorado and allowed six earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched on June 21 vs. Tampa Bay.
- He started 67 of his 72 appearances in the minor leagues from 2019-2023.

**WHAT THE METRICS SAY:** Ortiz ranks in the 98th percentile in Fastball Run Value according to Baseball Savant...He has limited opposing hitters to a .183 batting average against (23-for-126) when using his four-seam fastball this season.

**2023 RECAP:** Ortiz had two different stints with the Pirates last season, going 4-5 with a 4.93 ERA (73.0ip/40er) in his 15 starts and 1-0 with a 3.95 ERA (13.2ip/6er) in three relief appearances.

- Pitched with the Dominican Republic team in the World Baseball Classic, making one appearances and striking out three batters in 2.0 scoreless innings.
