A BILL FOR AN ACT

101	CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE COLORADO COMMISSION ON
102	AFFORDABLE HEALTH CARE DEVELOP A PROPOSAL UNDER ANY
103	APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAW TO ENABLE THE STATE TO OPERATE
104	A GLOBAL PAYMENT SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM FOR HOSPITALS IN
105	CERTAIN AREAS OF THE STATE.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill directs the Colorado commission on affordable health care to develop a proposal under any applicable federal law to enable the state

to modify the system for reimbursing hospitals located in certain rural areas of the state for treating medicare and privately insured patients using a total-cost-of-care model rather than a fee-for-service model. The commission is to develop and submit the proposal to the governor and specified legislative committees within 60 days after the bill takes effect and present its proposal to a joint meeting of the legislative committees.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-46-102, amend
3	(1); and add (1.5) and (7) as follows:
4	25-46-102. Definitions. As used in this article:
5	(1) "Commission" means the Colorado commission on affordable
6	health care established under section 25-46-103. "AFFORDABLE CARE
7	ACT" MEANS THE "PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE ACT",
8	PUB.L. 111-148, AS AMENDED BY THE "HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION
9	RECONCILIATION ACT OF 2010", PUB.L. 111-152.
10	(1.5) "Commission" means the Colorado commission on
11	AFFORDABLE HEALTH CARE ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 25-46-103.
12	(7) "MEDICARE" MEANS FEDERAL INSURANCE OR ASSISTANCE AS
13	PROVIDED BY TITLE XVIII OF THE FEDERAL "SOCIAL SECURITY ACT", AS

15	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-46-104, add (2.5)
16	as follows:

18	(2.5) (a) In addition to the powers and duties specified in
19	SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, WITHIN SIXTY DAYS AFTER THE
20	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (2.5), THE COMMISSION SHALL
21	DEVELOP A PROPOSAL UNDER ANY APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAW TO ENABLE
22	THE STATE TO OPERATE A GLOBAL PAYMENT SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM

THAT FOCUSES ON A TOTAL COST-OF-CARE MODEL RATHER THAN A
 FEE-FOR-SERVICE MODEL FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF HOSPITALS FOR
 MEDICARE PATIENTS. THE PROPOSAL MUST INCLUDE AT LEAST THE
 FOLLOWING COMPONENTS:

5 (I) DESIGNATION OF THE GEOGRAPHIC AREAS IN WHICH THE STATE 6 WILL OPERATE THE PILOT PROGRAM, FOCUSING PRIMARILY ON THE TWO 7 NONMETROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREAS DESIGNATED BY THE COLORADO 8 DIVISION OF INSURANCE FOR THE 2016 CALENDAR YEAR AS THE EAST AND 9 WEST GEOGRAPHIC RATING AREAS AND THE GRAND JUNCTION 10 METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA;

(II) DESIGNATION OF THE SPECIFIC HOSPITALS REQUIRED TO
PARTICIPATE IN THE PILOT PROGRAM;

(III) A GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF A TOTAL-COST-OF-CARE
REIMBURSEMENT MODEL FOR HOSPITAL REIMBURSEMENT, INCLUDING HOW
THE STATE MIGHT PROPOSE THAT THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT MODIFY
MEDICARE REIMBURSEMENT AND HOW THAT MODIFICATION IS INTENDED
TO IMPACT HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS;

18 (IV) SPECIFICATION OF WHAT AGENCY OR ENTITY WILL OPERATE
19 THE PILOT PROGRAM AND WHO WILL PROVIDE OVERSIGHT OF THE AGENCY
20 OR ENTITY OPERATING THE PILOT PROGRAM; AND

(V) A RECOMMENDATION INDICATING WHICH STATE DEPARTMENT
 OR AGENCY, OR COMBINATION OF DEPARTMENTS OR AGENCIES, SHOULD
 PURSUE THE PROPOSAL WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

(b) THE COMMISSION SHALL DEVELOP THE PROPOSAL WITHIN THE
TIME SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2.5), SUBMIT THE
PROPOSAL TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES
SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (8) OF THIS SECTION, AND PRESENT THE

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- 1 PROPOSAL TO A JOINT MEETING OF THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES DURING
- 2 THE 2016 LEGISLATIVE SESSION.
- 3 SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 4 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 5 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
