NOTICE OF DEADLINE REQUIRING FILING OF PROOFS OF CLAIM ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 7, 2024

TO ALL PERSONS AND ENTITIES WITH CLAIMS AGAINST THE ST. CHRISTOPHER'S, INC. AND/OR THE MCQUADE FOUNDATION (THE "DEBTORS"):

The General Bar Date. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the "Court") has entered an order (the "Bar Date Order") establishing **October 7, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Standard Time)**, as the last date and time for each person (excluding "Governmental Units," as defined in section 101(27) of the Bankruptcy Code) to file a proof of claim, including for any entity asserting a claim under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code (such deadline, the "General Bar Date") against the Debtors.

The Governmental Bar Date. The General Bar Date and the procedures set forth below for filing proofs of claim apply to all claims against the Debtors that arose before April 29, 2024 (the "Petition Date"), the date on which the Debtors commenced their cases under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), excluding claims that are specifically excluded from the Bar Date filing requirement. "Governmental Units" (as defined in section 101(27) of the Bankruptcy Code) have until **October 26, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Standard Time)**, the date that is one hundred and eighty (180) days after the Petition Date (the "Governmental Bar Date"), to file proofs of claim against the Debtors.

The Amended Schedules Bar Date. With respect to amendments or supplements to the Debtors' schedules of assets and liabilities (the "Schedules"), claimants have until the later of (i) the General Bar Date or the Governmental Bar Date, as applicable, and (ii) 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Standard Time) on the date that is thirty (30) days from the date on which the Debtors amend or supplement the Schedules (the "Amended Schedules Bar Date" and together with the General Bar Date, the Governmental Bar Date, and the Rejection Damages Bar Date, the "Bar Dates"), to file proofs of claim against the Debtors.

1. WHO MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM

You **MUST** file a proof of claim to vote on a chapter 11 plan filed by the Debtors or to share in distributions from the Debtors' bankruptcy estates if you have a claim that arose before the Petition Date (including any claim arising under section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code), and it is not a type of claim exempted under the Bar Date Order. Claims based on acts or omissions of the Debtors that occurred before the Petition Date must be filed on or before the Bar Dates, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated or certain before the Petition Date.

Under section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code and as used in this notice, the word "claim" means: (a) a right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, secured, or unsecured; or (b) a right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, secured or unsecured.

2. WHAT TO FILE FOR CLAIMS OTHER THAN ABUSE CLAIMS

Proof of claim forms and instructions may be obtained at (a) the Debtors' website located at <https://mystchristophers.org/>, or (b) the Court's website located at www.uscourts.gov/forms/bankruptcy-forms.

All proof of claim forms must be signed by the claimant or, if the claimant is not an individual, by an authorized agent of the claimant. It must be written in English and be denominated in U.S. currency (using the exchange rate, if applicable, as of the Petition Date). You also should attach to your completed proof of claim any documents on which the claim is based (if voluminous, attach a summary) or explanation as to why the documents are not available.

3. WHAT TO FILE FOR ABUSE CLAIMS

If you have an Abuse Claim, you should file an Abuse Proof of Claim Form, copies of which are enclosed and which also may be found at the Debtors' website located at <https://mystchristophers.org/>.

You may have an Abuse Claim if you experienced Abuse as a result of activities related to the Debtors before the Petition Date. For the purposes of an Abuse Proof of Claim Form, "Abuse Claim" means any liquidated or unliquidated claim (as defined in section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code) against the Debtors resulting or arising from any actual or alleged sexual conduct or misconduct, sexual abuse or molestation, sexual exploitation, indecent assault or battery, rape, pedophilia, ephobophilia, sexually related psychological or emotional harm, humiliation, anguish, shock, sickness, disease, disability, dysfunction or intimidation, any other sexual misconduct or injury, contacts or interactions of a sexual nature, including the use of photography, video or digital media, or other physical abuse or bullying or harassment without regard to whether such physical abuse or bullying is of a sexual nature, between a child and an adult, between a child and another child, or between a non-consenting adult and another adult, in each instance without regard to whether such activity involved explicit force, whether such activity involved genital or other physical contact, and whether there is or was any associated physical, psychological or emotional harm to the child or non-consenting adult, including such claims that may be covered by the Child Victims Act, the Adult Survivors Act, the Victims of Gender-Motivated Violence Protection Act, and any other similar statutes; provided that an Abuse Claim shall not include any liquidated or unliquidated claim for contribution, indemnity, reimbursement or subrogation, whether contractual or implied by law (as those terms are defined by the applicable non-bankruptcy law of the relevant jurisdiction), and any other derivative claim of any kind whatsoever, whether in the nature of or sounding in contract, tort, warranty or any other theory of law or equity whatsoever, including any indemnification, reimbursement, hold-harmless or other payment obligation provided for under any pre-petition settlement, insurance policy, or contract.

If you have a claim for abuse that is not covered by the foregoing definition of Abuse Claim, then you should file a General Proof of Claim Form as set forth in the Bar Date Order and this notice.

4. WHEN TO FILE ALL CLAIMS

All proofs of claim and Abuse Claims must be filed so as to be received on or before October 7, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Standard Time) (for all persons except Governmental Units) or October 26, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Standard Time) for all Governmental Units.

Any person or entity that holds a claim that arises from the rejection of an executory contract or unexpired lease must file a proof of claim by the later of: (a) the General Bar Date, (b) 5:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Standard Time, on the date that is thirty (30) days after entry of an order confirming a Chapter 11 plan rejecting such executory contract or unexpired lease, and (c) 5:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern Standard Time, on the date that is thirty (30) days after entry of the Rejection Order. All pre-petition claims of any kind or nature relating to the rejection of executory contracts or unexpired leases must be filed by the Rejection Bar Date.

Proofs of claim will be deemed filed only when actually received at the address listed above or via the Electronic Filing System on or before the applicable Bar Date. Proofs of claim may not be delivered by facsimile, teletype or email transmission.

6. WHERE TO FILE ABUSE PROOFS OF CLAIM AND GOVERNING CONFIDENTIALITY PROTOCOL

The Bar Date Order provides that a Confidentiality Protocol shall govern the submission of certain proofs of claim. Abuse Proof of Claim Forms will not be available to the general public unless such claimant requests, solely in his, her, or their discretion, for such proof of claim to be made public by checking the applicable box on his, her, or their claim forms or by order of the Court after an application has been made to the Court on notice to all parties in interest.

7. CONSEQUENCES OF FAILURE TO FILE A CLAIM

ANY HOLDER OF A CLAIM THAT IS NOT EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE BAR DATE ORDER AND THAT FAILS TO TIMELY FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM IN THE APPROPRIATE FORM SHALL NOT BE TREATED AS A CREDITOR WITH RESPECT TO SUCH CLAIM FOR THE PURPOSES OF VOTING ON ANY PLAN FILED IN THESE CASES AND PARTICIPATING IN ANY DISTRIBUTION IN THE DEBTORS' CASES ON ACCOUNT OF SUCH CLAIM.
