

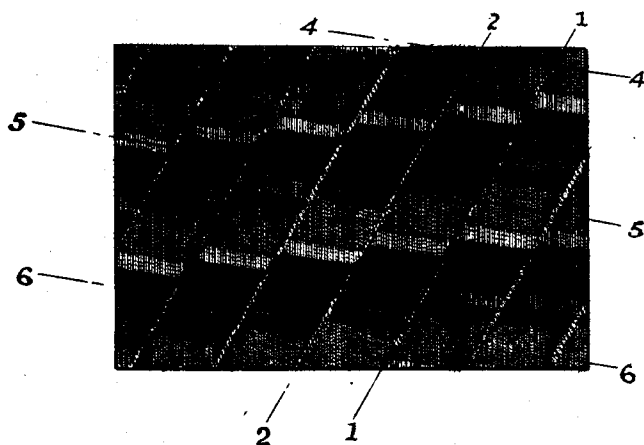

DESIGN FOR A KNITTED FABRIC OR SIMILAR ARTICLE

Application filed May 15, 1930. Serial No. 35,652. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MOSES SCHREIBER, a citizen of the United States, residing at 564 West 160th Street, New York city, borough of Manhattan, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Knitted Fabric or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure illustrates a piece of knitted fabric, showing my new design. The element of the design consists of a rhomboid bounded

by the lines 1—1, 2—2, and 4—4, 5—5, while the design unit is contained within the area outlined by the lines 5—5, 6—6, and the vertical marginal edges connecting the same, which design unit is repeated in the relation indicated by its extension beyond the indicating lines.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a knitted fabric or similar article substantially as shown and described.
