FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the bottom of the game board of FIG. 1 embodying my new design.

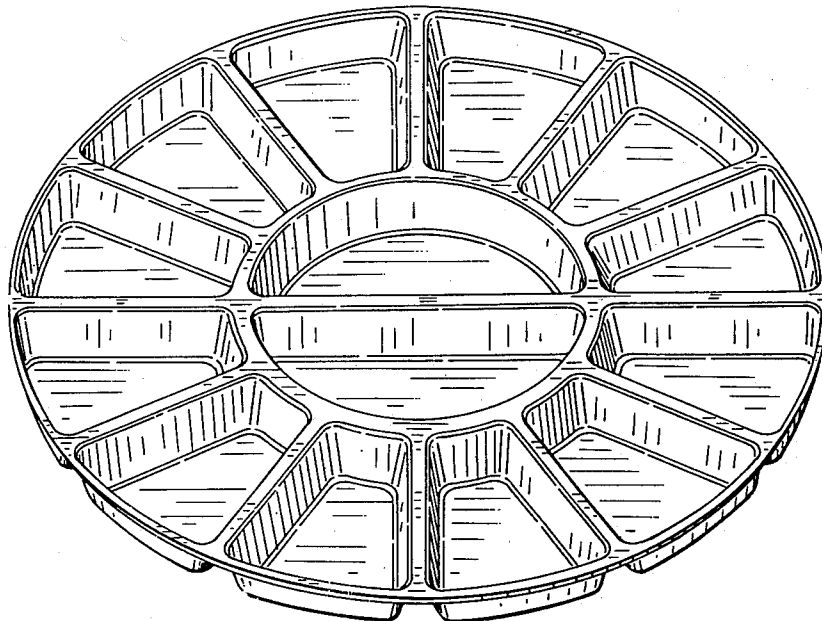

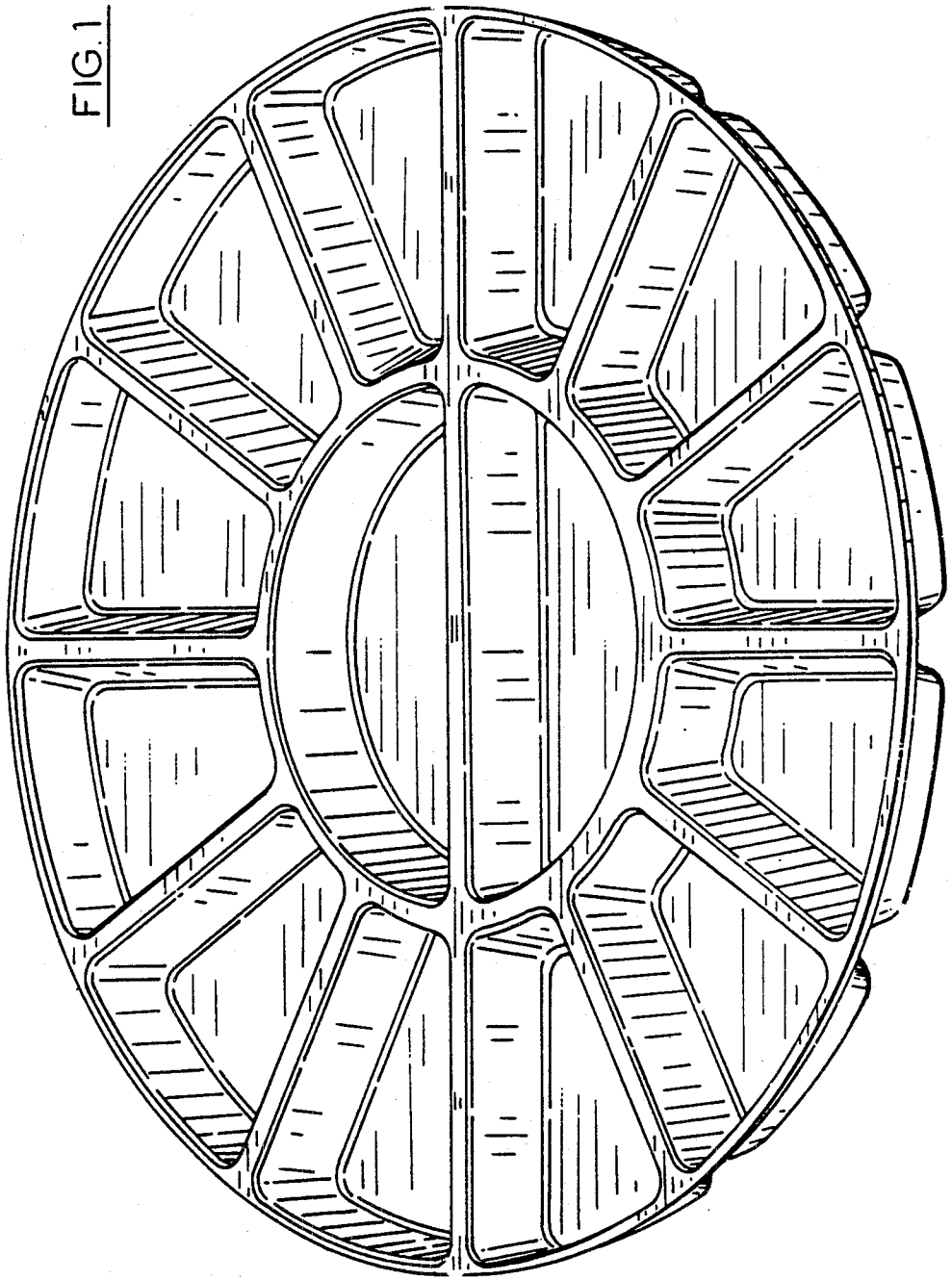
