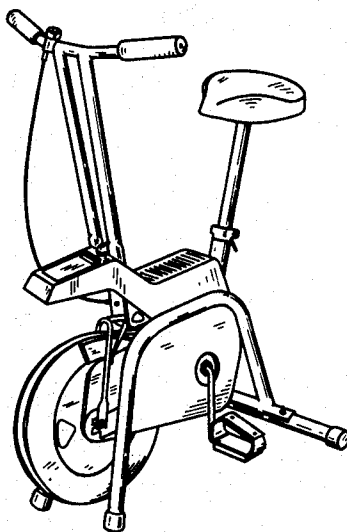

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an exercycle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, and,
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



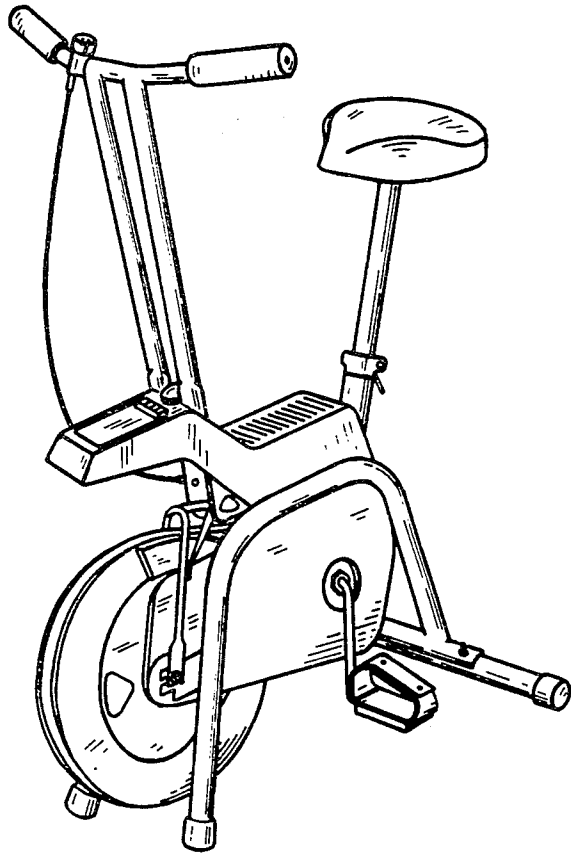

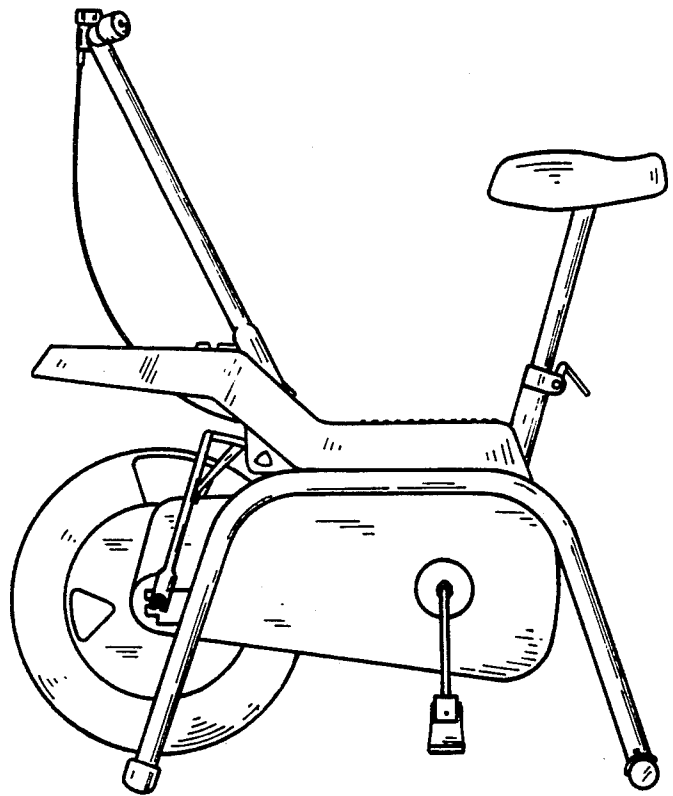

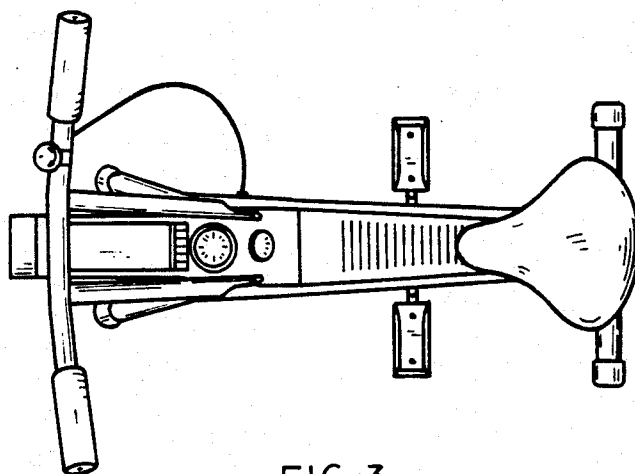

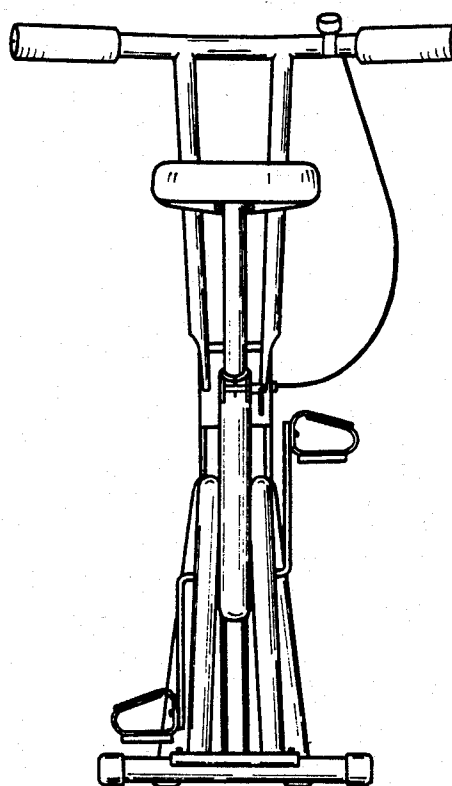
