

DESIGN FOR A COMBINED STAND AND TRAY FOR SMOKERS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Miner G. Ketchum, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Indianapolis, in the county of Marion and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Stand and Tray for Smokers, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of the stand embodying my new design; Figure 2 is a top plan view thereof, and Figure 3 is a front elevational view of the stand.
