DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a perspective view of glasses embodying my new design;


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.










