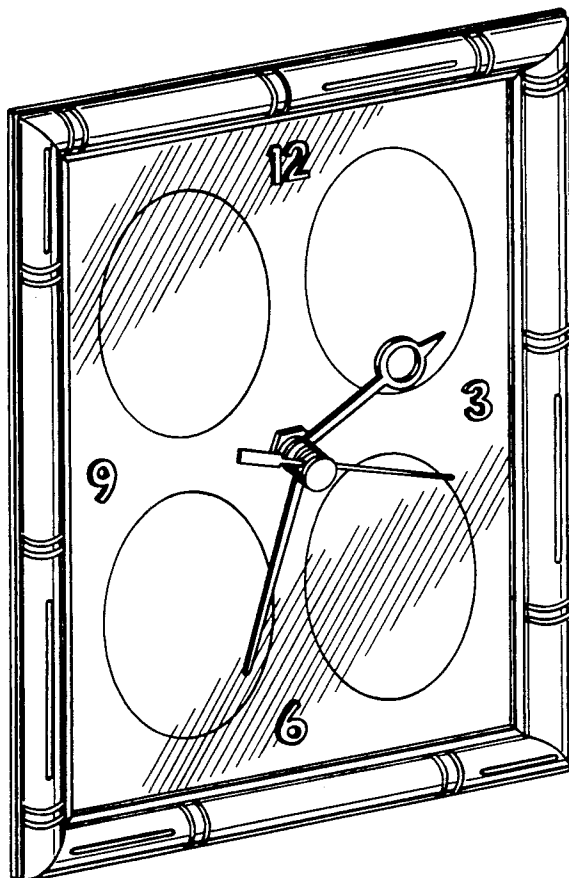

The ornamental design of a picture clock, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a picture clock showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right rear perspective view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



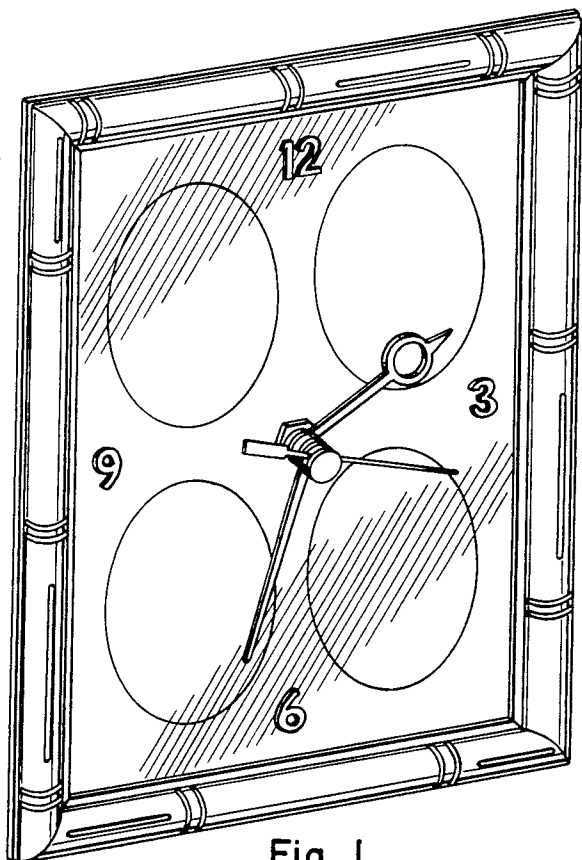

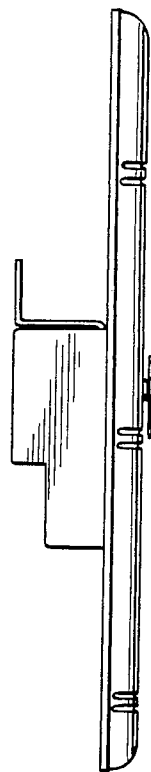

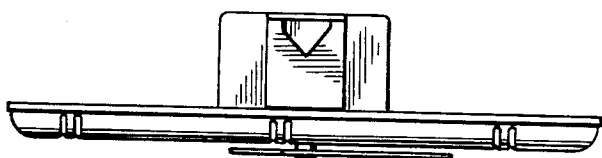

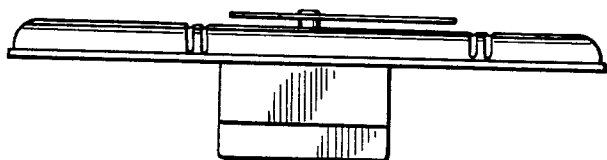

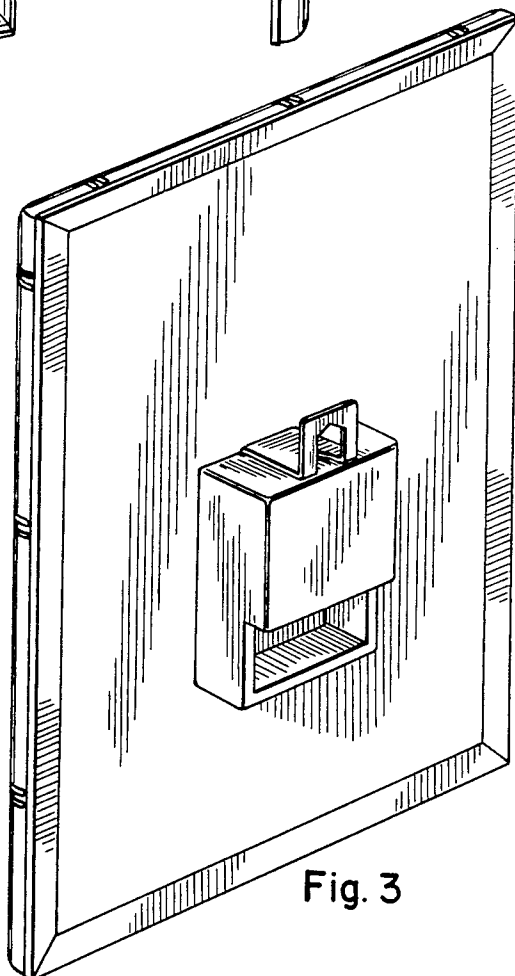
