

SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT

Second Reading

1 Amend printed bill, page 5, after line 21 insert:  
2 "SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-505, **add** (4)  
3 as follows:

4 **42-2-505. Identification documents - individuals not lawfully**  
5 **present - rules.** (4) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
6 REVENUE SHALL NOTIFY THE REVISOR OF STATUTES IN WRITING OF THE  
7 DATE WHEN THE DEPARTMENT HAS IMPLEMENTED THE PROVISIONS OF  
8 SENATE BILL 24-182, ENACTED IN 2024, BY E-MAILING THE NOTICE TO  
9 REVISOROFSTATUTES.GA@COLEG.GOV. THIS NOTICE IS RECEIVED UPON  
10 THE DATE IDENTIFIED IN THE NOTICE THAT THE DEPARTMENT HAS  
11 IMPLEMENTED THE PROVISIONS OF SENATE BILL 24-182, ENACTED IN 2024,  
12 OR, IF THE NOTICE DOES NOT SPECIFY THAT DATE, UPON THE DATE OF THE  
13 NOTICE TO THE REVISOR OF STATUTES.

14 **SECTION 5. Effective date.** (1) Except as otherwise provided  
15 in this section, this act takes effect upon passage.

16 (2) Section 4 of this act takes effect only if Senate Bill 24-182  
17 becomes law, in which case section 4 takes effect upon passage, or on the  
18 effective date of Senate Bill 24-182, whichever is later.

19 (3) Sections 1 to 3 of this act take effect upon notice to the revisor  
20 of statutes pursuant to section 42-2-505 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes,  
21 as enacted in section 4 of this act."

22 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
