Representative Bradley moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Bradley amendment, (J.001) to HB24-1187, to show that said amendment passed and that HB24-1187, as amended, passed.

Amend printed bill, page 52, line 2 strike "Services" and substitute "Services^{58a}".

Page 53, line 7 strike "Services" and substitute "Services^{58a}".

Page 78, after line 3 insert:

"58a DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, OFFICE OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH INSTITUTES AT FT. LOGAN; MENTAL HEALTH INSTITUTES AT PUEBLO -- IT IS THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S INTENT THAT \$5,000,000 GENERAL FUND OF THIS APPROPRIATION BE USED TO SUPPORT RETENTION AND INCREASE COMPENSATION FOR NURSES EMPLOYED BY THE STATE."

PURPOSE: Adds a footnote to the Department of **Human Services** specifying the General Assembly's intent that \$5.0 million General Fund be used to support retention and increase compensation for nurses employed by the state.
