Representative Bradley moved to amend the Report of the Committee of the Whole to reverse the action taken by the Committee in not adopting the following Bradley amendment, (J.002) to HB24-1187, to show that said amendment passed and that HB24-1187, as amended, passed.

Amend printed bill, page 4, line 5, strike "Survey<sup>41</sup>" and substitute "Survey<sup>41</sup> SURVEY<sup>41,41a</sup>", in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column strike "25,582,368" and substitute "~~25,582,368~~", and in the GENERAL FUND column strike "18,932,095" and substitute "~~18,932,095~~".

Page 4, after line 5, in the ITEM & SUBTOTAL column insert "32,682,368" and in the GENERAL FUND column insert "26,032,095".

Adjust affected totals accordingly.

Page 71, after line 15 insert:

"41a DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S OFFICE, GENERAL ADMINISTRATION, SALARY SURVEY -- IT IS THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY'S INTENT THAT \$7,100,000 GENERAL FUND OF THIS APPROPRIATION BE USED TO SUPPORT RETENTION AND INCREASE COMPENSATION FOR NURSES EMPLOYED BY THE STATE.".

PURPOSE: Adds \$7.1 million General Fund to the Department of **Human Services** with a footnote indicating the General Assembly's intent that the increase be used to support retention and increased compensation for nurses employed by the State.
