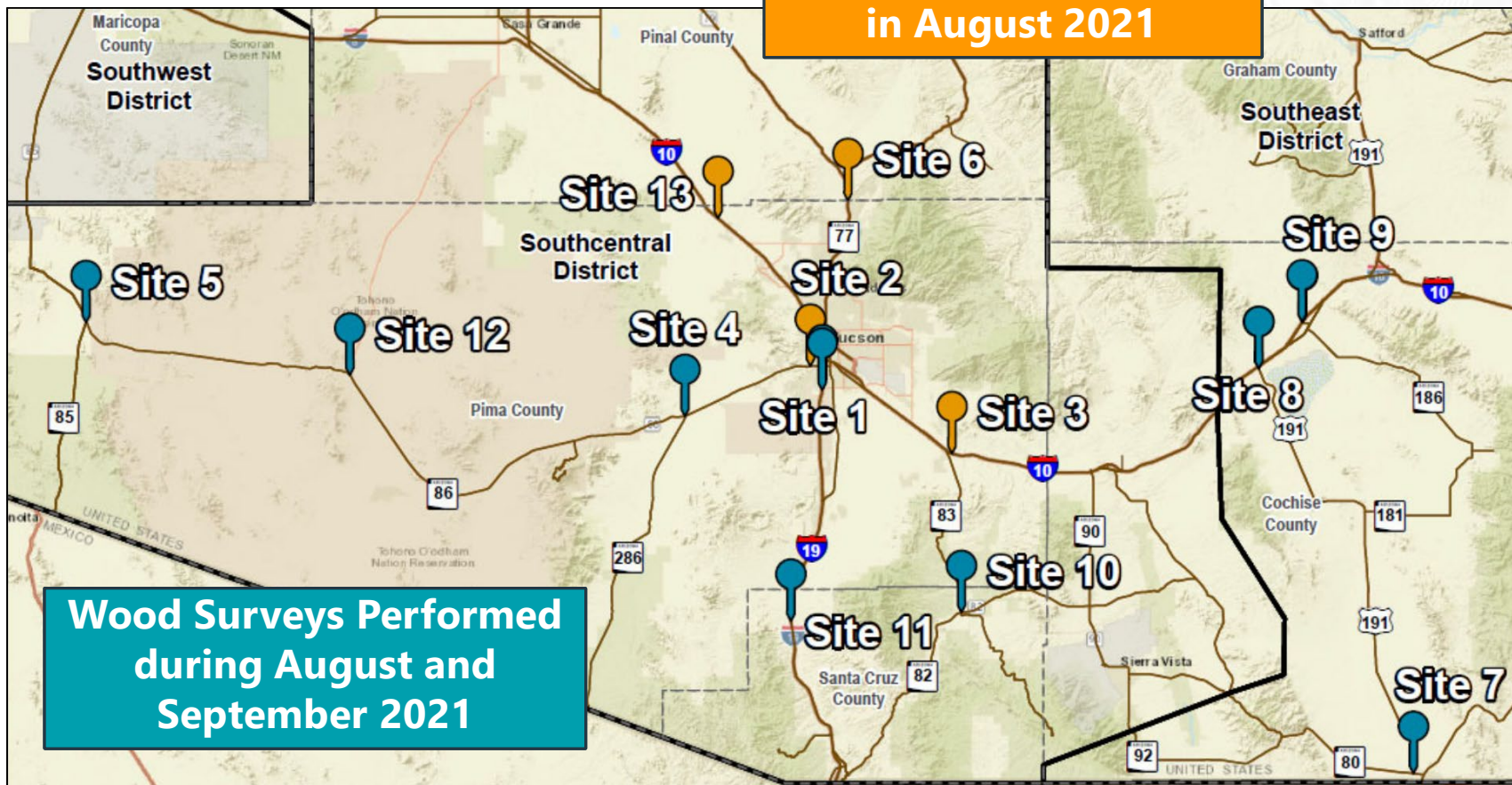
# WHAT HMEP GRANTEEES CAN DO TO COMPLY WITH EO13985

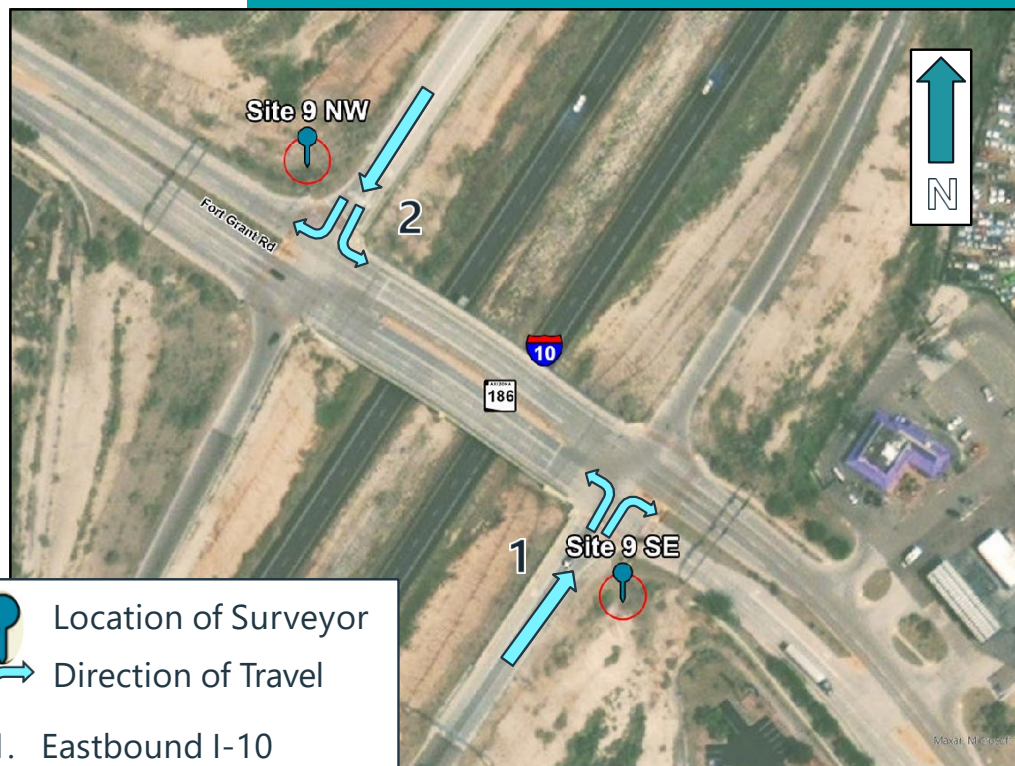
**Wood Surveys Performed

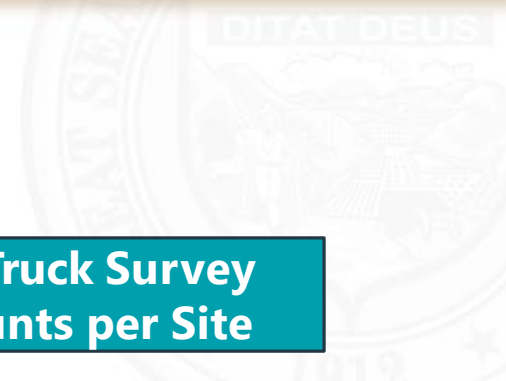
