

Armenia

Women, Business and the Law 2024 (WBL2024) presents an index covering 190 economies and structured around the life cycle of a working woman. In total, 35 questions are scored across eight indicators. Overall scores are then calculated by taking the average of each indicator, with 100 representing the highest possible score. Data refer to the laws and regulations that are applicable to the main business city (Yerevan). Different rules may apply in other jurisdictions so local legislation should be reviewed. Based on this approach, **Armenia scores 90.6 out of 100.0**. The overall score for Armenia is higher than the regional average observed across Europe and Central Asia (85.8). Within the Europe and Central Asia region, the maximum score observed is 96.9 (Cyprus).

Relative Strengths

When it comes to constraints on freedom of movement, constraints related to marriage, laws affecting women's work after having children, gender differences in property and inheritance, and laws affecting the size of a woman's pension, Armenia gets a perfect score.

Areas for Improvement

When it comes to laws affecting women's decisions to work, laws affecting women's pay, and constraints on women starting and running a business, Armenia could consider reforms to improve legal equality for women.

For example, one of the lowest scores for Armenia is on the indicator measuring laws affecting women's decisions to work (the WBL2024 Workplace indicator). To improve on the Workplace indicator, Armenia may wish to consider adopting criminal or civil penalties for sexual harassment in employment.

Recent Reforms

During the past year (October 2nd, 2022 to October 1st, 2023), Armenia enacted legislation protecting a woman from sexual harassment in employment.
