

# **Education Specialist Position Description**

Education Specialists are passionate about saving species through public engagement and education. By participating in a Taxon Advisory Group (TAG), Species Survival Plan (SSP), or SAFE program as an Education Specialist, educators advance the conservation and understanding of species through project-based work aligned with the public engagement goals and objectives of the program. Education Specialists work collaboratively with other Education Specialists and are supported by the TAG, SSP or SAFE program's Education Advisor. Involvement as an Education Specialist is a great way to network, develop skills, and contribute to the conservation of species.

Estimated time commitment: project dependent

#### Key Responsibilities:

- Participate in setting public engagement goals and SMART objectives and outcomes, led by the program's Education Advisor.
- Undertake project-based work in alignment with the identified goals and objectives.
- Work collaboratively with other Education Specialists to achieve project goals and objectives.
- Communicate regularly and effectively with other Education Specialists and the Education Advisor.
- Familiarize self with species within the program.

#### Criteria:

#### Skills and Aptitudes:

- Experience planning, developing, implementing, and/or evaluating education programming.
- Interest and enthusiasm for the species within the program.
- Ability to work both independently and as a member of a team to complete a project.
- Ability to maintain effective working relationships with other members of the team.

- Statement of institutional support, if applicable. See application materials.
- Letter of recommendation. See application materials.

#### **Education Specialist Application Process:**

- 1. A TAG, SSP, SAFE program, or the Conservation Education Committee (CEC) may begin the process by expressing the need for an Education Specialist in a particular program. Individuals may also express an interest in working as an Education Specialist with a particular program.
- 2. The TAG/SSP/SAFE program and CEC will announce the vacancy. Interested individuals are encouraged to submit an application to the CEC Education Advisors to Animal and Conservation Programs Initiative directly at <a href="mailto:ceceducationadvisors@gmail.com">ceceducationadvisors@gmail.com</a>.
  - \*\*All applications for Education Specialists will be reviewed by the CEC Education Advisors to Animal and Conservation Programs Initiative. The CEC maintains a database of Education Advisors and works with Education Advisors to ensure that they are supported and effective in their roles. Program leaders or current Education Advisors and Specialists who receive expressions of interest directly or would like to recommend an individual to support their program should direct these inquiries to the CEC.
- 3. Upon receipt of an application, the CEC will review the application for completeness and qualifications. If qualified, the application will be shared with the TAG/SSP/SAFE program leader with the CEC's recommendation.
- 4. If there are multiple applicants, the TAG/SSP/SAFE program and CEC will work collaboratively to determine the top candidate.
- 5. When an applicant is selected, the CEC will convey the offer and arrange for an onboarding call with program leaders, other Education Advisors and Specialists within the TAG/SSP/SAFE program, and a representative of the CEC.
