

Application Requirement

- Online application, including \$25 application fee
- Official transcripts and degree certificates or certified true copies in English of all college and university records sent directly from each institution to CLU. Students may be required to complete an official transcript evaluation including GPA equivalence and courseby-course listing.
- **TOEFL**, **IELTS**, **GMAT** or **GRE** exam scores if taken. Although not always required, Cal Lutheran reserves the right to request these scores to assist in admission decisions.
- Personal Statement
- **Two letters of recommendation** from community leaders, business professionals or professors, sent directly to Cal Lutheran or submitted with the application.
- Financial Responsibility Statement or official bank statement
- Copy of passport information page

Conditional Admission

Cal Lutheran grants conditional admission to applicants to complete an approved English language program and qualify for an English exam waiver. Cal Lutheran partners with ELS Language Centers, which has centers across the U.S., including two in California.

MBA

LENGTH 1 - 2 years

START Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer

Executive MBA

LENGTH 18 months

START Fall

Our program is designed for successful, careerminded people striving to excel at peak performance. The curriculum emphasizes teamwork and provides exclusive networking opportunities. You are coached by a professional mentor chosen for you based on your industry and professional goals. In this flexible hybrid program, during each eight-week term you and your cohort of student peers take one online and one in-person course that meets over two weekends.





MS in Management (STEM)

LENGTH 1 year

START Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer

For those with a nonbusiness background who want to advance professionally, this STEM-designated program builds the management skills to increase your market competitiveness. You study a cross-section of subjects, including accounting, economics and financial strategy, with an emphasis on operational leadership and interpersonal communication. Upon completion, you can earn an MBA with as few as four additional courses.

MS in Information Technology (STEM)

LENGTH 1 - 2 years

START Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer

Our STEM-designated technology program prepares you to be a strong technical leader who can effectively plan, design, implement and manage IT-enabled organizational change. You work with the latest technologies, such as Hadoop, R, Tableau, SQL and Python. And you can customize the curriculum to best suit your career goals, choosing from a general track or one of three specialties offered in information technology management, data analytics and cybersecurity.

MS in Quantitative Economics (STEM)

LENGTH 1 year

START Fall

Our STEM designated MS in Quantitative Economics is rated one of the leading economic forecasting programs in the country. Working with faculty from Cal Lutheran's prestigious Center for Economic Research and Forecasting (CERF), you master the skills necessary to become an astute economic analyst, including understanding of economic theory, model building, data collection and forecasting. CERF is highly awarded for its accuracy in forecasting and serves as a laboratory for your coursework and assignments.

Master in Public Policy and Administration

LENGTH 18 months - 2 years

START Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer

This program offers the combined focus of creating policy and managing it for the public good, building a versatile skill set for those interested in leading public-facing efforts for government, government agencies, non-for-profits, think tanks and the private sector. Your classes are combined with in-depth fieldwork through group projects assisting local governments and agencies. The Sacramento Policy Institute offers the opportunity for formal meetings with state lawmakers, lobbyists, think tanks and media influencing the world's largest subnational economy.

Master of Science in Clinical Psychology



Our clinical psychology program combines a focus on pioneering research techniques with extensive training in clinical practices. Built on the scientist-practitioner model and open, reproducible science values, the program helps you develop expert skill in using the R statistical programming language to analyze data and engage in practical, science-based problem solving. Students in this program often continue their graduate studies in a doctoral program.

Master of Science in Counseling Psychology

LENGTH 2 years

START Fall

Students in the counseling psychology program work toward licensure as a marriage and family therapist. In our onsite, state-of-the-art community counseling centers, you work with a diverse client population to earn required practicum hours. Specializations offer a more intensive level of study in areas such as psychological trauma and attachment theory.

In our APA-accredited PsyD program, students study and practice the theory of science-based cognitive behavior.
