What is the Language Access Hub?



The California Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) received funding from the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to develop a new "Pilot Language Access Hub" for California County Agricultural Commissioners (CACs).

What are the available services?



Agricultural Commissioners and their staff have access to:

- 24/7 interpretation call line for their pesticide use enforcement activities.
- Interpretation services during their field inspections or investigative interviews.
- Translation services related to the pesticide use enforcement program.

There are over 100 languages available, including: Cantonese, Hindi, Hmong, K'iche', Korean, Mandarin, Mixtec (Alto/Bajo), Punjabi, Spanish, Tagalog, Triqui, and Zapotec.

What does this mean for me?





You or your community-based organization (CBO) representative can:

- <u>request an interpreter</u> when contacting your Agricultural Commissioner to report a pesticide incident or ask any pesticide use questions.
- request an interpreter if you visit or call the CAC office.
- <u>ask CAC staff for the translation</u> of inspection reports, emails, flyers, or notices related to the pesticide use enforcement program.
