

Request for Access to CDOT Programs & Activities

It is CDOT's objective to provide access to CDOT programs and activities for all individuals.

The following services are available:

Interpretation & Translation Services: CDOT provides reasonable language assistance free of charge upon request. Contact the Office of Environmental Justice & Equity to make translation or interpretation requests related to any CDOT public meeting or service.

Access for the Visually and Hearing Impaired: Dial 711 or (800) 659-3656 to reach Relay Colorado. Relay Colorado is a free service that provides full telephone access to people who are deaf, hard of hearing, deaf-blind or speech-disabled.

Accessible Meeting Locations & Facilities: CDOT strives to provide services and hold meetings in locations accessible to people with disabilities. Contact the Office of Environmental Justice & Equity at dot_civilrights@state.co.us to make an accommodation request.
