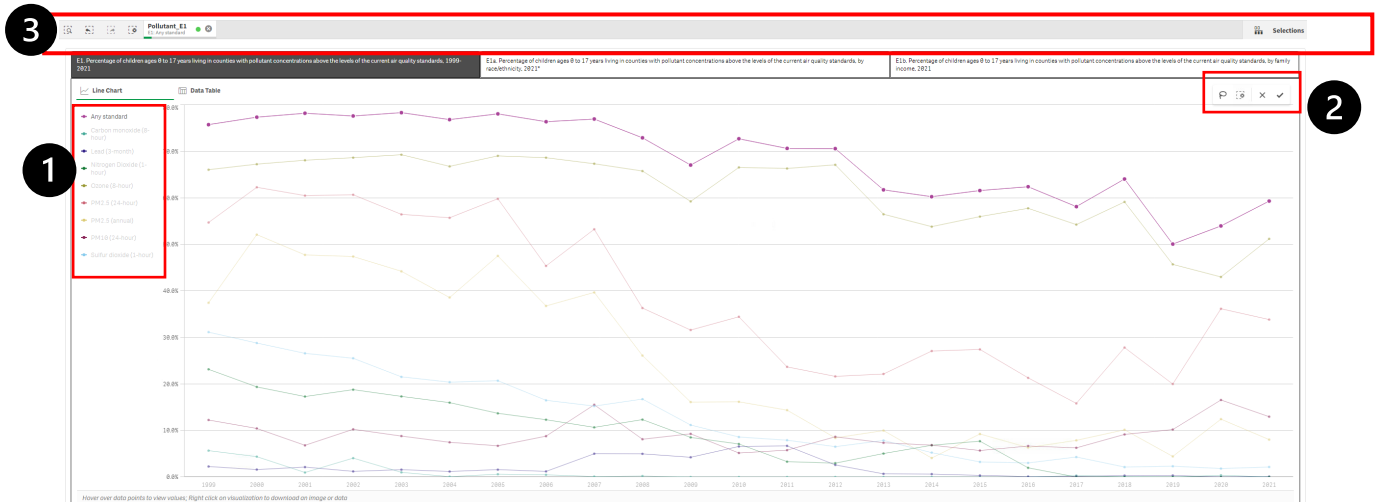



How to use the interactive features of ACE graphs and data tables

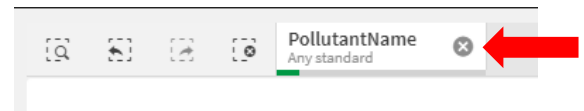
View in a new window: If you want to view a graph in a separate tab or window of your web browser, click on the “Click to open in new window” link. This will open the graph in a separate window or tab, which may be useful if you are using a smaller screen.

View and interact with graphs: In graphs with multiple lines or bars, you can use filters to choose which data series you wish to display. This can be useful if you want to compare a subset of data in the graph (for example, specific pollutants or specific races/ethnicities).



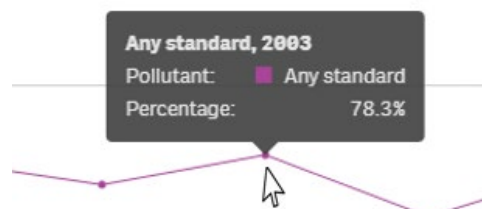
- **Toggle individual data series on or off:**

- On a graph, click in the legend (see item 1 above) to select a category or categories (the unselected categories will be dimmed), then click the check mark in the bar at the **right corner** of the chart (see item 2 above) to confirm your selection. If you want to cancel your selection, click the X to the left of the check mark.
- To clear your selection(s), look for the bar at the very **top left** of the visualization (see item 3 above and click on the  icon. (Example shown is for Indicator E1; the text will vary by indicator.)



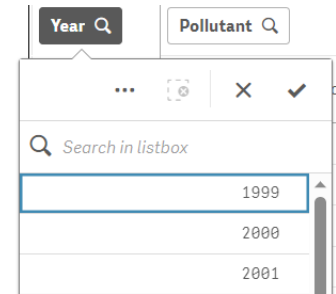
- **See individual data points.**

- Hover your mouse over a bar segment or any point along a line to reveal a pop-up with data.



View and interact with data tables: You can also use filters in the data tables.

- Each graph has a corresponding data table, accessible by clicking on the Data Table icon.
- In a data table, click on rows or columns to make your selection and click the check mark in the bar at the **right corner** of the data table (item 2 above) to confirm your selection. You can make additional data selections as a next step (e.g., if you selected a column and confirm your selection, you can now select specific rows within that column).
- Another way to select data in tables is through the filters that appear above columns. In the example at right, clicking on the “Year” filter brings up a box with a list of all years; you can select individual or multiple years and click the check box at the top of the list box to confirm your selection.



Export images and data:

- To export a graph as an image file or PDF, or to export data as an Excel file, position your cursor over the main body of the graph or data table, right-click, then choose “Export as an image,” “Export to PDF,” or “Export data.”
- When the export is ready, a pop-up window will appear with a link you can click to save the file to your computer.
- Please note:
 - Indicator titles and notes are not included in the exports.
 - Data cannot be exported from indicators that are grouped together in tabs (for example, the graphs for Indicators E1, E1a, and E1b are tabs in one interactive exhibit).
