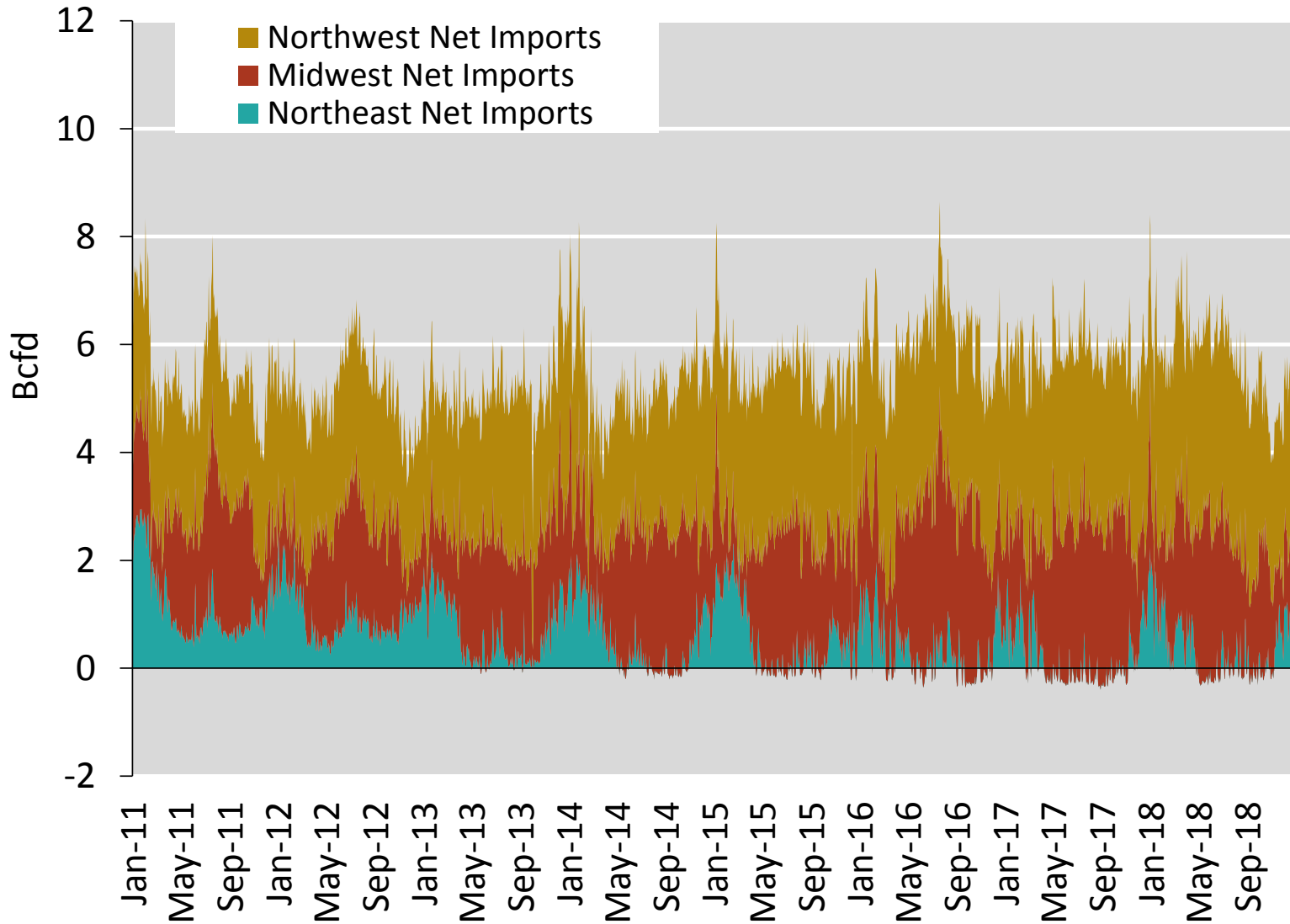


**U.S. NG Supply and Demand Dec-17 YTD vs. Dec-18 YTD**

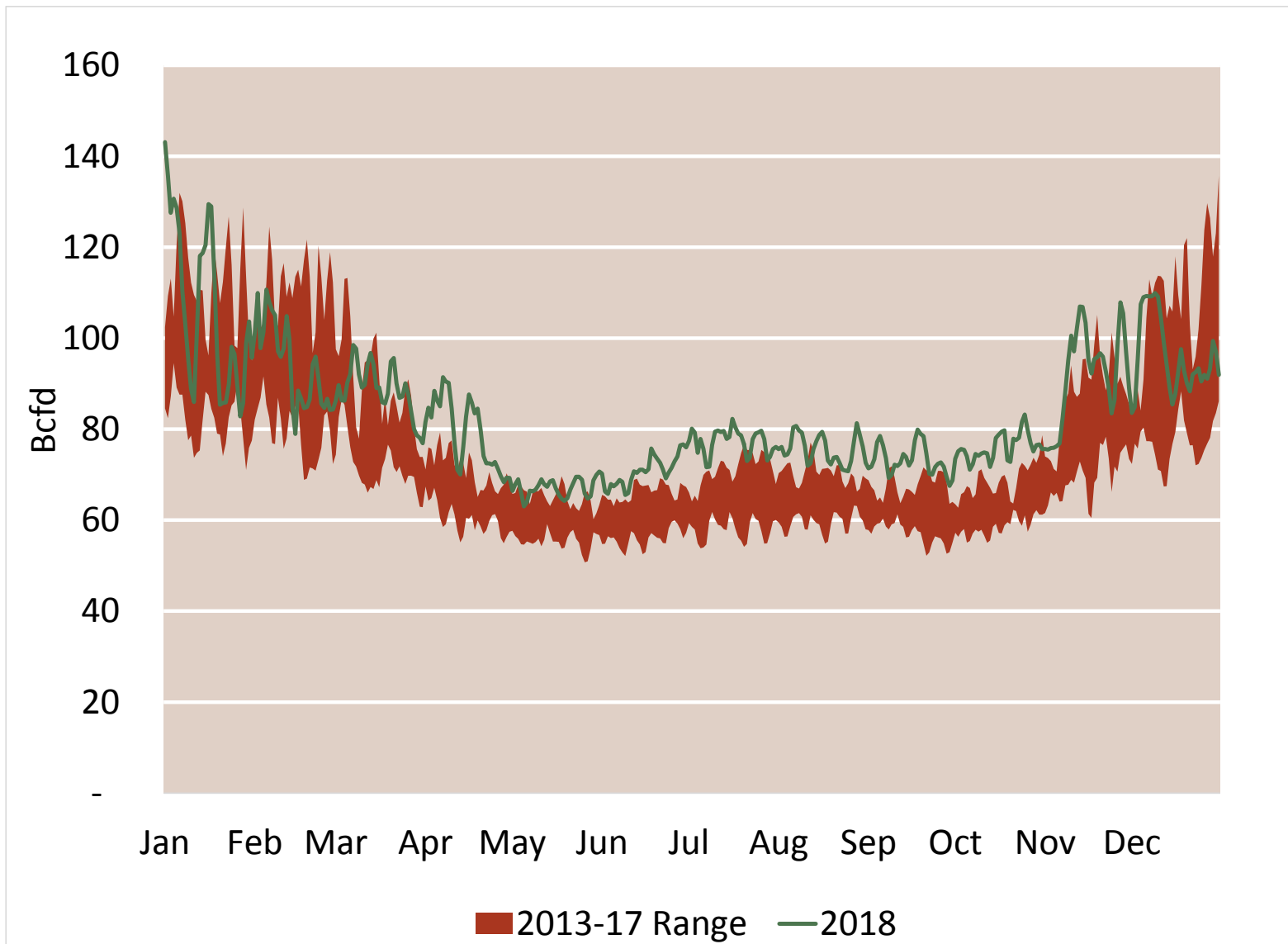

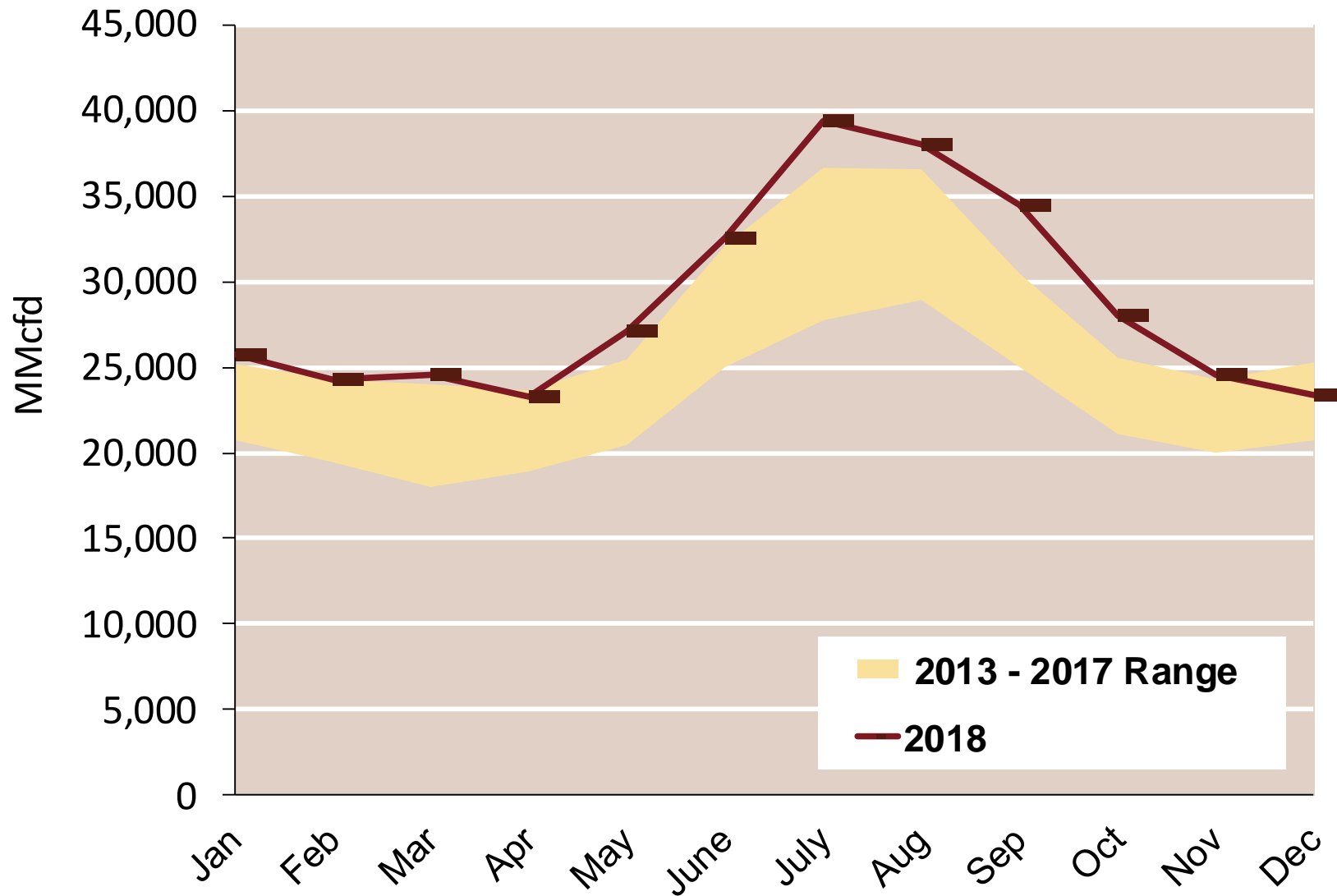

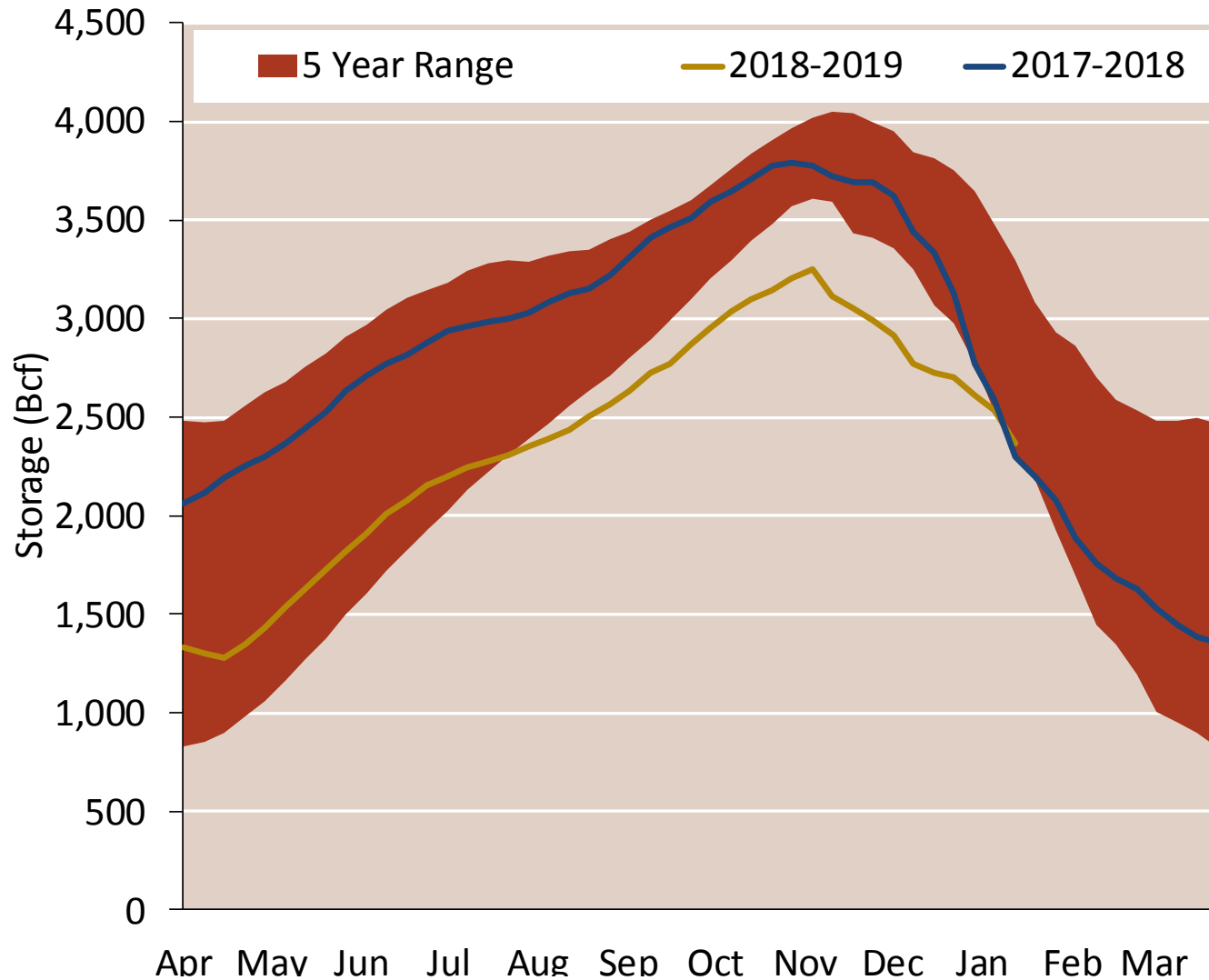
## Total U.S. Natural Gas Demand All Sectors



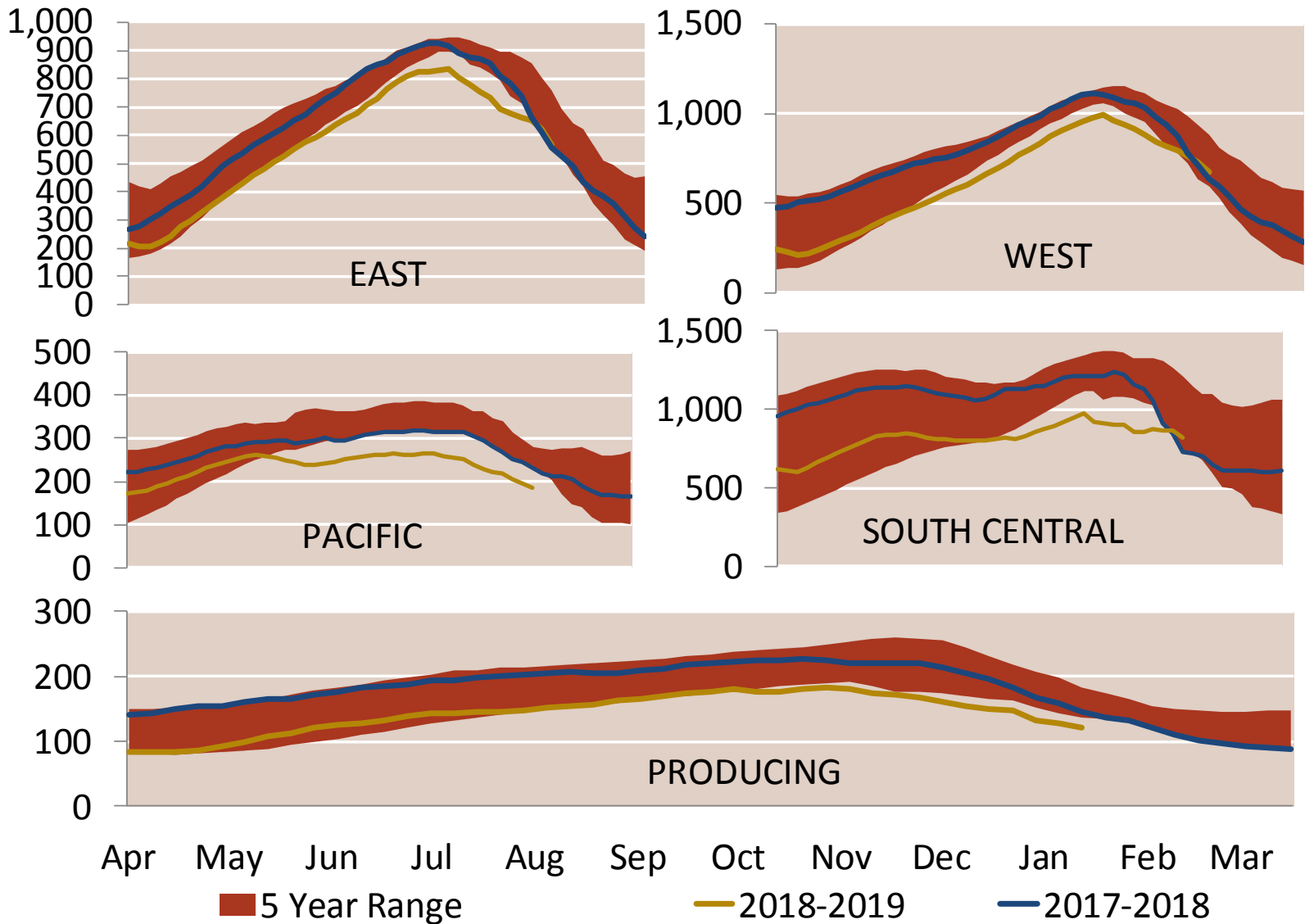
## U.S. Natural Gas Consumption for Power Generation

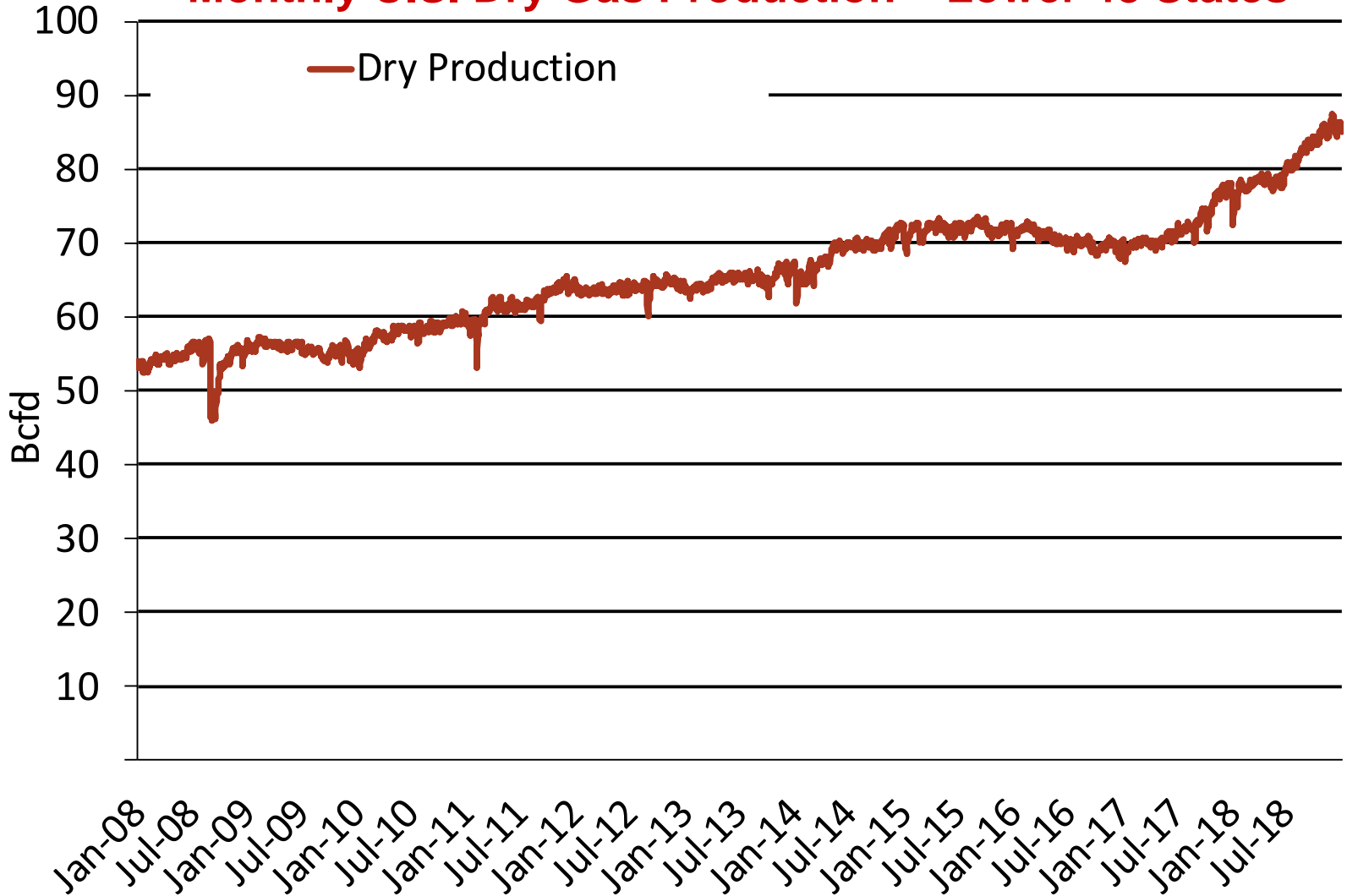

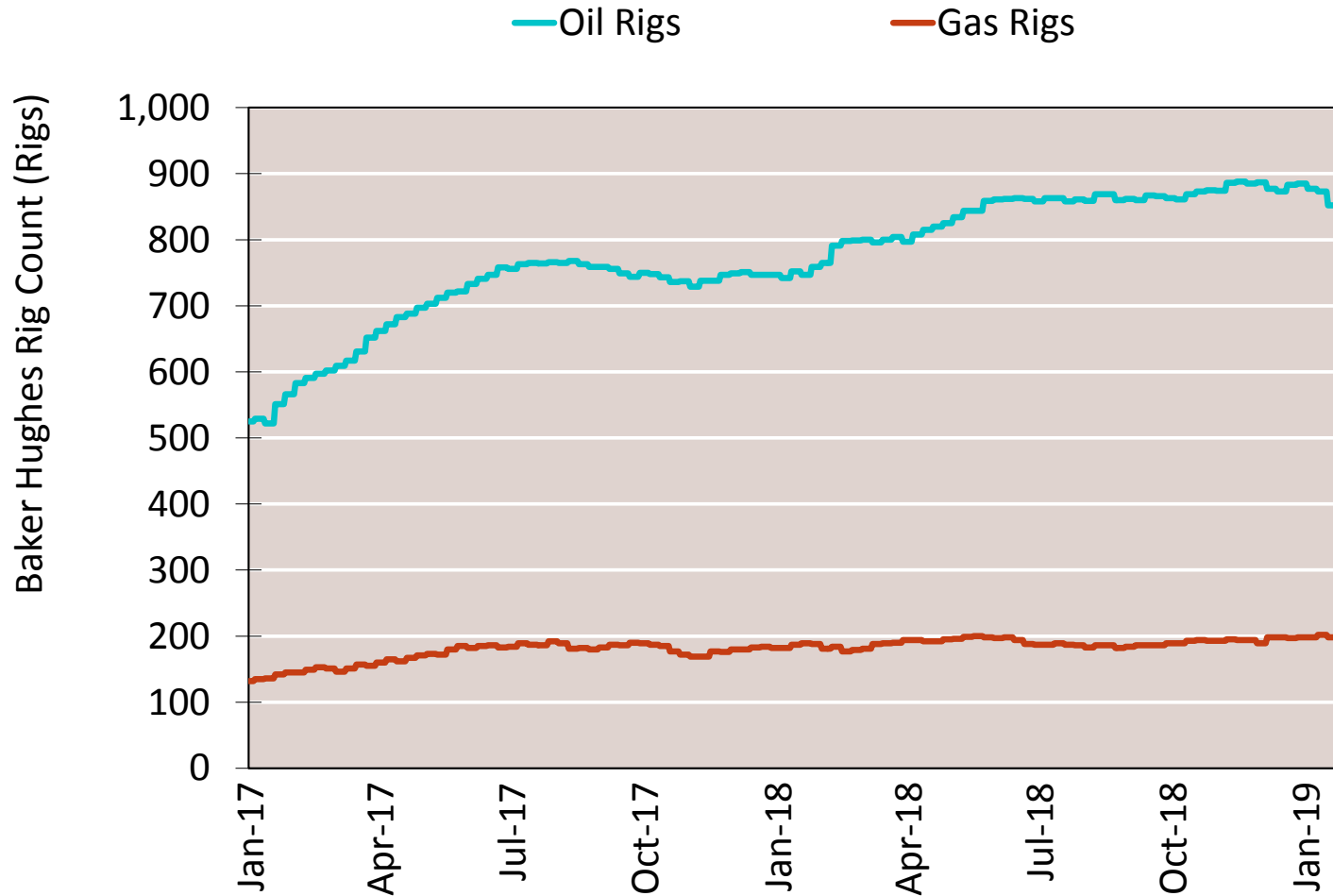


## Monthly U.S. Dry Gas Production – Lower 48 States



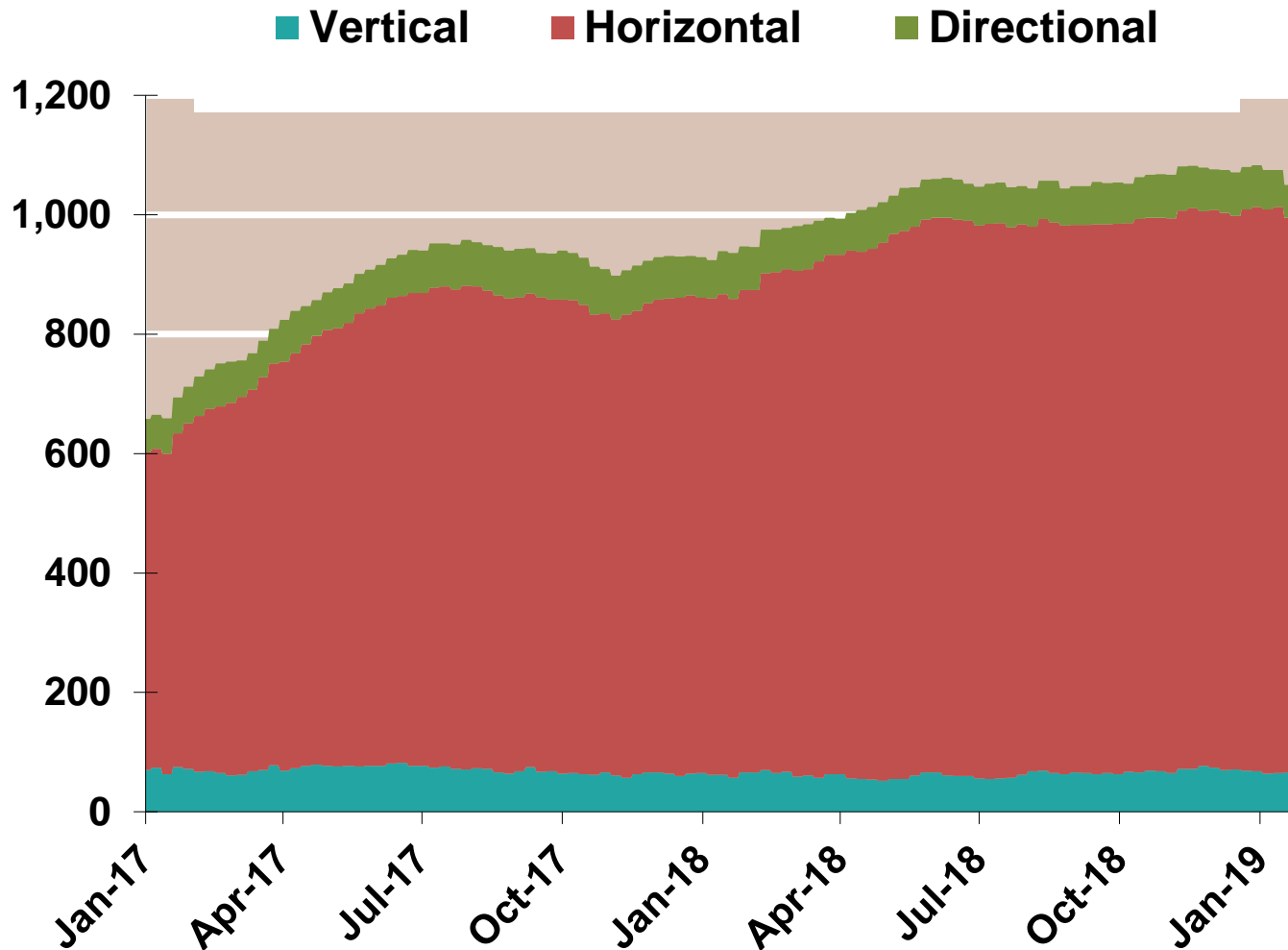

## NG Rigs by Fuel Type

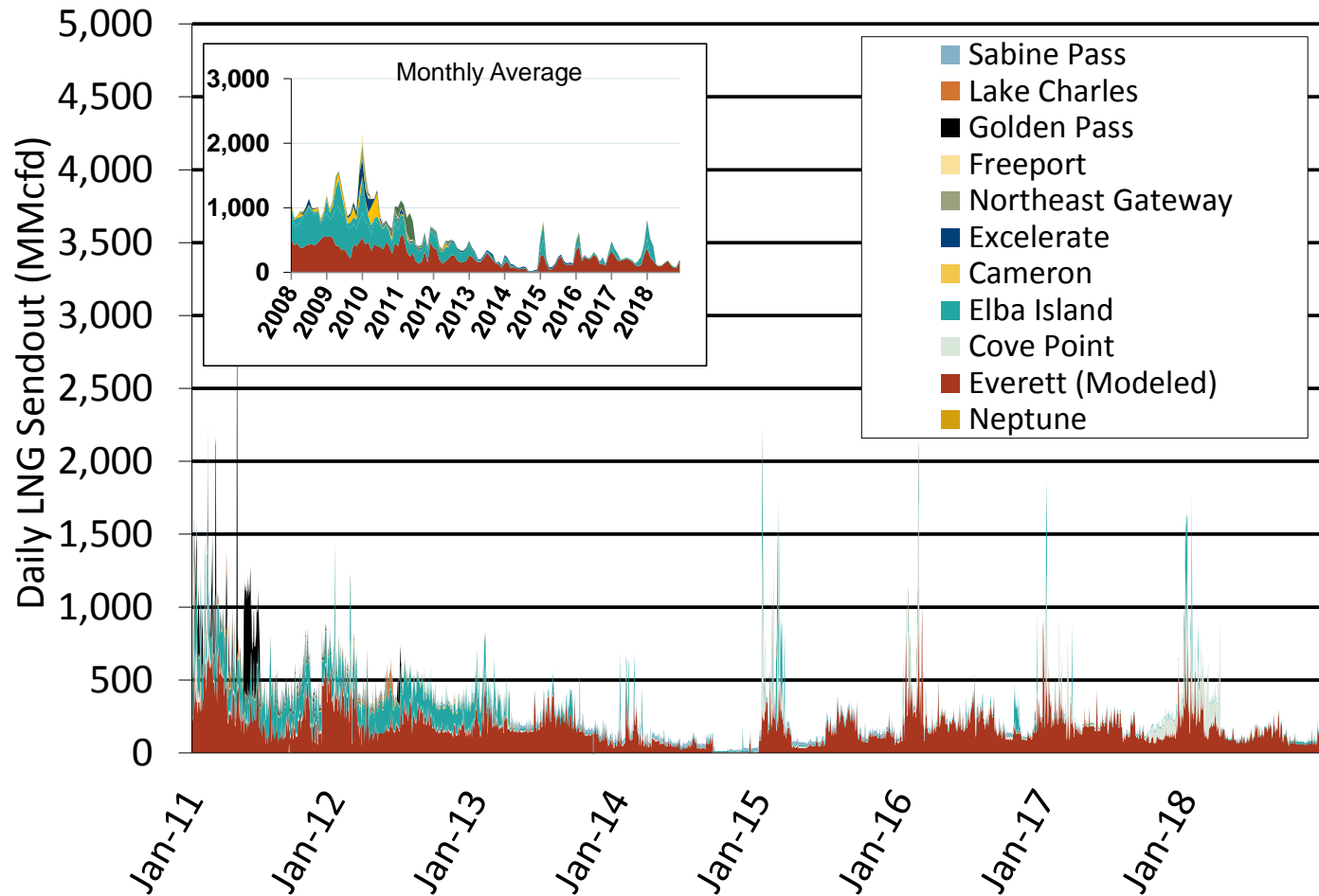


## NG Rig by Direction

Baker Hughes Rigs By Drill Type

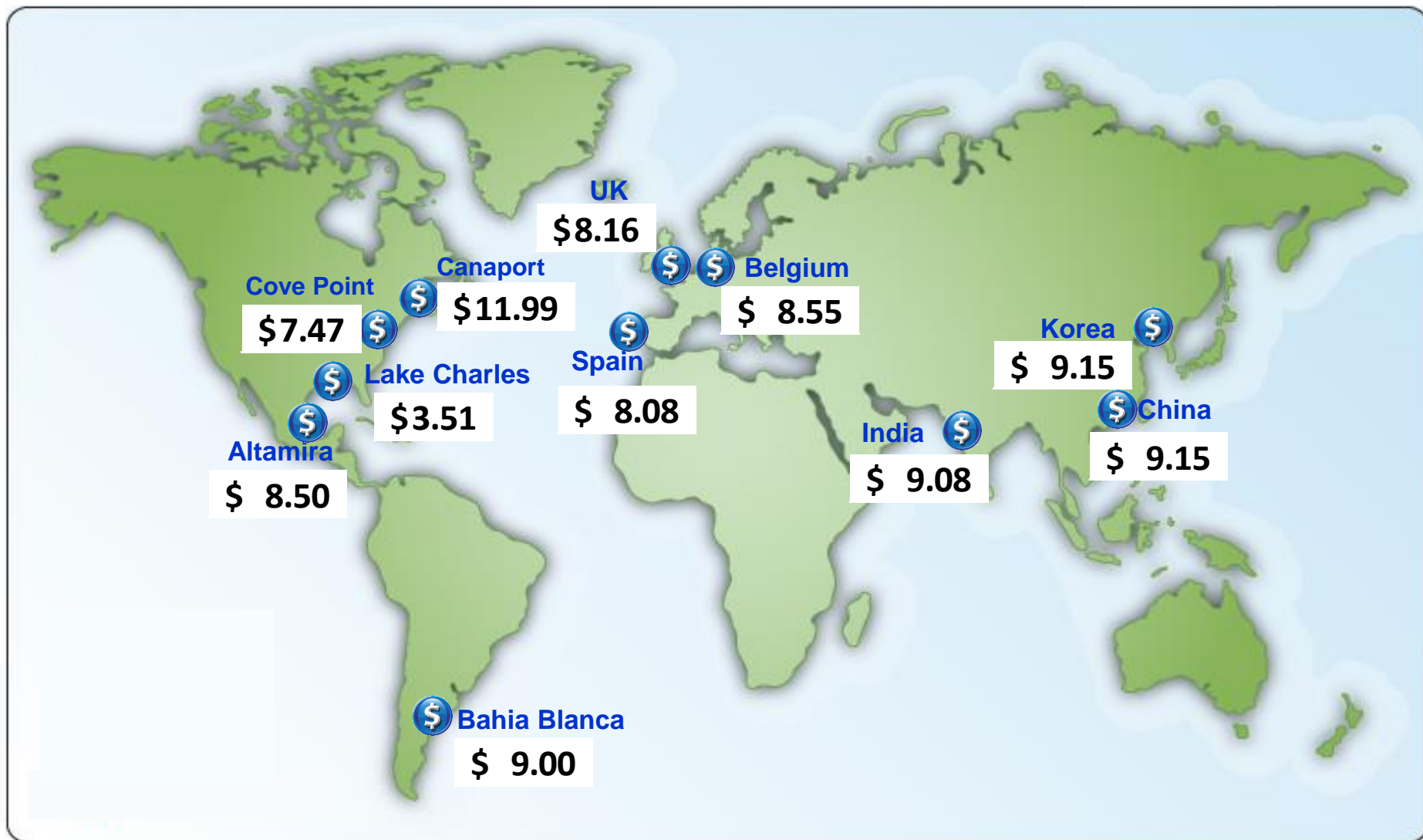


## Daily Gas Sendout from Existing U.S. LNG Facilities
