

Identification of High Demand Teacher Needs for 2023-24

Recommended High Demand Teacher Needs

This report identifies which certification areas represent the greatest need among teachers statewide. Traditionally, this report has referred to this analysis by the title “Critical Teacher Shortage Areas.” However, in recognition of the 2021 R.E.A.C.H. Act (HB 1507) and subsequent implementation of Florida’s increasingly more diagnostic reviews of supply and demand for all credentialed professions, the language herein this report shall accordingly begin to evolve in alignment with Florida’s more data-driven approach to identifying professional needs and supporting those needs to data-informed policy options.

Using the information provided below, the recommended high demand areas for the 2023-24 school year are as follows:

- Exceptional Student Education (ESE)
- English
- Science-General
- English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
- Reading
- Science-Physical
- Math
- Tech Education (CTE)

The information in this report is NOT a direct measure of the number of new teachers needed to staff Florida’s schools but can be used to determine the projected needs for specific subject area coverages in the upcoming school year. The high demand areas above represent certification areas where the gaps between supply and demand are the greatest. In other words, larger than typical proportions of teachers who are not certified in the appropriate field are being hired to teach courses where significant vacancies exist and where postsecondary institutions do not produce enough graduates to meet the needs of Florida’s K-12 student population. It is important to keep in mind that fewer than 10% of courses statewide across all subject areas were taught by teachers who were not certified in the subject area. The process used to determine these high demand areas, supply versus demand gaps, is presented below.

Background

Section (s.) 1012.07, Florida Statutes (F.S.), requires the State Board of Education (SBE) to annually identify critical teacher shortage areas, referred to as high demand teacher needs in this report, based on the recommendations of the Commissioner of Education. This statute is accompanied by SBE Rule 6A-20.0131, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), which specifies that the list of high demand areas identify high-need content areas and high-priority location areas using the following information:

1. The number and percentage of positions in each discipline filled by teachers not certified in the appropriate field;
2. The annual supply of graduates of state-approved Florida teacher education programs for each discipline;
3. The number and percentage of vacant positions in each teaching discipline; and
4. Areas which may be identified pursuant to rules adopted by district school boards. These areas shall be identified based on consideration of at least the information specified in items one through three above and submitted to the Department of Education no later than June 1st of each year.

Additionally, ss. 1012.22(1)(c)4.b. and 1012.22(1)(c)5.c.(III), F.S., include provisions requiring local school districts to incorporate identified areas into both their grandfathered and performance salary schedules.

Determining High Demand Teacher Needs

The high demand teacher needs, for 2023-24 were determined using information provided in Exhibits 3 through 5. The Department used the information in each of the exhibits to create rankings for each measure in Exhibit 1.¹ Rankings were then averaged across all measures to produce the final rankings.

In Exhibit 1 below, the shaded and bolded subject fields indicate the recommended high demand teacher needs for 2023-24. The final column in Exhibit 1, “Final Rank,” shows that ESE was in first place with an average rank of 6. English was ranked second, followed by Science-General, ESOL, Reading, Science-Physical, Math and CTE as high demand teacher needs.

¹ The rankings order the data with 1 being the subject area that shows the most need for additional teachers. In the case of a tie, all subject areas in the tie are assigned the rank indicating a higher need for additional teachers. For example, if three subject areas tie for third place (i.e., there is no way to distinguish between third, fourth and fifth place), they would all be assigned third place.

Information on High Demand Teacher Needs

Data on teachers currently in the workforce and their areas of certification are presented below to provide context for the recommended high demand teacher needs. This information covers the following: certification areas in which the majority of teachers are currently certified; the number of courses taught by teachers who were not appropriately certified for the courses they were teaching; the projected number of teacher vacancies as reported by school districts; and the number of recent completers of state-approved teacher preparation programs in Florida. Additional information is provided on the number of courses being taught by teachers who were not certified in the appropriate field for the courses they were teaching in high-priority locations.² The following exhibits provide information on teacher supply and demand:

It is important to note and emphasize that all data are as reported by school districts or teacher preparation programs.

Exhibit 2 provides the total number of certifications held by teachers in 2021-22 by certification area. It is important to note that a teacher may be certified in multiple subject areas. If a teacher held a certification in multiple subject areas, the certification is counted once for each subject area; therefore, the sum of the total number of certifications reported in the table below does not equate to the total number of certified teachers. **The total number of certifications increased by 8% from 2020-21 to 2021-2022.** The most common teacher certification area for the 2021-22 school year was Elementary Education, making up 18.92% of all certifications. This was closely followed by ESOL at 18.42%. High demand areas for 2023-24 are shaded and bolded in the exhibit below. Following Elementary Education and ESOL, the numbers drop off with Reading making up 12.81% of certifications and ESE making up 9.77% of certifications. The seven recommended critical teacher high demand areas account for about 50.71% of all certifications (n=243,661). The complete crosswalk of “Certification Subject Codes to Certification Areas” can be found in Appendix B.

Districts prefer to hire teachers certified in the appropriate field(s) for the courses they teach, to ensure students receive instruction at the level of rigor reflected in Florida's B.E.S.T. Standards. In some cases, this is not possible and in order to staff classrooms and offer certain courses, districts must hire teachers who are out of field; however, it is important to keep in mind that **fewer than 10%** of courses statewide across all subject areas were taught by teachers who were not certified in the subject area (55,405 out of 587,607 courses). Exhibit 3 is ranked based on the degree to which a particular subject area is more prevalent among the courses being taught out of field than it is among the courses being offered in the state. Though this is an important metric used to identify subject areas experiencing the greatest need. The difference is calculated between the percentage of total courses reported and the percentage of total courses taught out-of-field. A large and negative difference indicates that the certification area represents a larger share of the courses taught by out-of-field teachers than it does of the overall courses offered. Students taking courses requiring certification in these areas are more likely to receive instruction from an out-of-field teacher. Certification areas are ranked in Exhibit 3 based on this difference indicating a proportionally greater need for in-field teachers.

This information provides detail on the certification areas that are currently in demand across all school districts based on how frequently courses are being taught by teachers without the required certification relative to those courses' prevalence among

course offerings in Florida. ESE had the highest percentage of courses taught by teachers without the required certification relative to its prevalence among course offerings in Florida.

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Most of the recommended High Demand Teacher Needs for 2023-24 are among those with the highest projected vacancies and the highest number of vacancies for 2022-23 reported by school districts. Exhibit 4 provides the total number of vacancies for the 2022-23 school year that districts reported as of September 1, as well as the total number of vacancies districts project that they will need to fill before the start of the next school year.

However, it is important to keep in mind that each of these vacancies does not necessarily represent a teacher vacancy, since one teacher may teach courses in multiple subject areas. For example, a district could report two vacancies by subject area, one in chemistry and one in biology, but fill both needs by hiring one science teacher to cover both subject areas. Therefore, because these counts are designed to identify subject area needs, they will be higher than the actual number of teachers that districts need to hire. **The actual number of teacher vacancies districts reported as of September 1, 2022, was 4,440.** For context – Florida has roughly 185,000 teachers and the state’s vacancies represented approximately 2.4% of teaching positions, which is also around 1.2 open positions per school on average. Survey results released by the U.S. Department of Education in August 2022 found that nationwide each school had about 3 unfilled teaching positions, on average. With Florida’s average of 1.2 open positions per school, the state’s teacher vacancy rate was less than half that of the rest of the country.

Additionally, it is important to note that historically the number of vacancies by certification area projected by school districts for the next school year has typically been an overestimate of the actual number of vacancies by certification area that are reported by school districts the following school year. For example, in last year’s report, districts projected 9,079 vacancies by certification area for the 2022-2023 school year. However, in this year’s report the actual number of vacancies by certification area reported by school districts for the 2022-2023 was 5,547, as of September 1, which is nearly 40 percent lower than the number districts projected last year. This information is collected from each district and is typically used to plan recruitment efforts, including The Great Florida Teach-In held annually. This highlights the anticipated subject areas of teacher demand seen across all school districts.

Florida has a robust array of options to ensure that classrooms are staffed by qualified teachers that do not require completion of traditional teacher preparation programs. The number of post-secondary students earning a certification in a particular content area in Florida is just one indicator of new teachers available to fill vacancies in the state. Exhibit 5 presents the most recent information on new completers reported by teacher education programs across Florida. There are a number of [additional pathways](#) to obtaining a Florida teaching certificate that are not represented in counts of program completions in the exhibit below.

Consistent with s. 1012.07, F.S., high-priority locations are identified as high-density, low-economic urban schools; low-density, low-economic rural schools; and schools that earned a 2021-22 school grade of “F” or three consecutive grades of “D” or below, pursuant to s. 1008.34, F.S. Low-economic schools are those that have 75 percent or more students who qualify for free or reduced-price lunch. Urban and rural school distinctions are based on the 2020-21 National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) locale codes which are a measure of geographic status on an urban continuum that ranges from “large city” to “rural” based on the standards used by the Census. The list of high-priority school locations can be found in Appendix A.

Exhibit 6 provides information on the number of high-priority school locations and the proportion of courses at those locations being taught by teachers who were not certified in the appropriate field for the courses they teach (out-of-field) and teachers who were certified in the appropriate field for the courses they teach (in-field).³ The statewide percentage of courses taught by out-of-field teachers for all schools with at least one school grade component is 8.29%. Additionally, 10.51% of courses at urban/low-economic schools and 6.43% of courses at rural/low-economic schools are being taught out-of-field. Additionally, Exhibit 6 provides comparative data for other types of school locations (e.g. charter, non-charter schools, etc.). Though this information does not contribute to the identification of high demand teacher needs, it is provided for context when reviewing high-priority school locations designated as such pursuant to Rule 6A-20.0131, F.A.C., and ss. 1012.07 and 1008.34, F.S.
