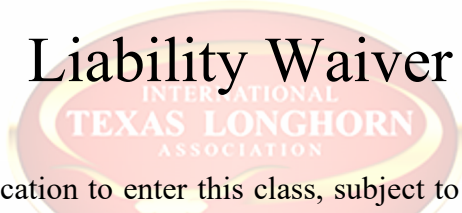

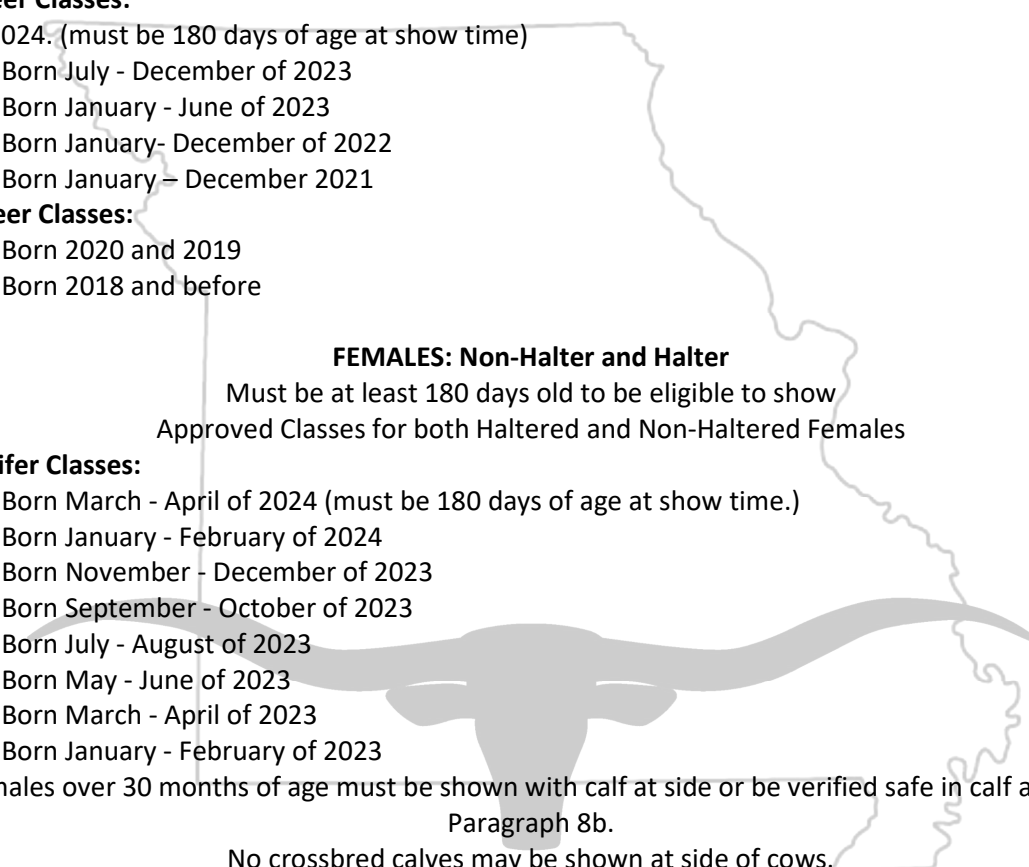

Group classes will be shown at halter.

All Animals must be at least 180 days old.

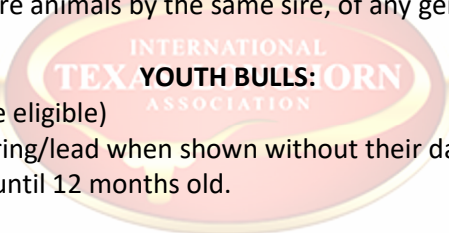
Paragraph 21. These approved classes are valid for the entire calendar year.

Animals competing in Produce of Dam and Get of Sire must have competed in previous classes.

Class 31 - Produce of Dam – Two or more animals from the same dam, any gender.

Natural birth only—calves resulting from Embryo Transfer will not be eligible to compete in this class.

Class 32 - Get of Sire – Three or more animals by the same sire, of any gender



(Must be at least 180 days old to be eligible)

All bulls must be shown with nose ring/lead when shown without their dam.

Temporary nose ring may be used until 12 months old.
