The Lindsay Department of Public Safety invites you to take part in our 2nd Annual
Community Police Academy!

The Community Police Academy provides an opportunity to learn and see first-hand the functions of not just our Department, but all the services our great City provides!

During the six-week course, attendees will be exposed to many aspects of police work, including traffic enforcement, gangs, criminal investigations, criminal prosecution, narcotics, and the use of firearms. You will also learn from our Fire Department, Human Resource Department, Finance Department, and City Services. Participants will graduate with a good working knowledge of the Lindsay Department of Public Safety. Each participant will also be required to take part in a ride-along and will be afforded an opportunity to shoot our firearms as well.

This course is not intended to train people to become Police Officers. The main objective of the Community Police Academy is to increase understanding between the residents of our community and the Police Officers who serve them, with an overall goal of building strong and lasting relationships.

To be eligible to attend you must minimally meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Live, work, worship or have attended school in the City of Lindsay
- Have no felony convictions or significant criminal history

Those interested must complete an application, which is available at the Police Department or Finance Department / City Hall as well as on the city website. The closing date for applications is Friday, August 18th at 5:00 pm. A selection committee will review the applications to determine the eligibility of each candidate and will select attendees accordingly. We are limited to a maximum of 20 members, ***so don't delay!***

The academy is scheduled to begin Thursday, September 21st and conclude with a graduation ceremony on Thursday, October 26th. Classes are scheduled for each Thursday from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm, and 100% attendance is required to graduate.
