TRANS TECH PUBLICATIONS (TTP, Switzerland) offers OPEN ACCESS and full reading rights for all the journal publications available on <https://www.scientific.net/>.

Tailor-made tiering for different kinds of institutions offering full OA (CC-BY-4.0) for their authors in all of the applicable periodicals. The Reading Rights to 18 Periodicals will include archival access.

There will be NO Article Processing (APC) charges thanks to full reading rights.

<p>Are abroad sites / international sites of participating institutions excluded?</p>	<p>No, they are not excluded.</p>

<p>How to request for a paper submission?</p>	<p>The link for placing a submission request: https://www.scientific.net/ForPublication/Paper</p>
<p>How to submit the paper?</p>	<p>The papers shall be submitted personally by the correspondent authors from their authenticated accounts directly on Scientific.Net platform to the relevant title from the list of titles that are open to the author for submission: specific conference, special issue or journal.</p>
<p>What information is needed from authors to identify their right to publish Open Access?</p>	<p>Full name, email and affiliation, ORCID (optional).</p>
<p>Which information is automatically retrieved during the process of submitting a paper for publication to https://www.scientific.net/?</p>	<p>Email domain, Affiliation (Name of Institute, Acronyms, Aliases).</p>
<p>Does the author receive information when allowed to publish Open Access under their organization?</p>	<p>Yes, authors receive information during the process of their papers and when it is accepted for publication.</p>
<p>When will the paper be published in Open Access?</p>	<p>As soon as the publisher has accepted the paper for publication and the organization has done the eligibility check, the authors will receive an email that informs them about the paper being published with an Open Access license.</p>
<p>How does the process of author identification work? How are matching authors and participating institutions matched?</p>	<p>1st step: The corresponding author enters the names of all co-authors in the editing tool (publisher submission system). 2nd step: The publisher system does recognize the affiliation of the authors. 3rd step: The publisher verifies the author affiliations with the author information given in the article.</p>
<p>Is the publisher checking the affiliation of the authors?</p>	<p>Yes, the publisher has an internal verification process in place.</p>
<p>Which license is offered for OA articles?</p>	<p>CC-BY 4.0</p>
<p>Are deviations of the article license offered (such as to funders' requirements or authors' choice)?</p>	<p>Special requirements from the funders will be considered and added to the paper.</p>
<p>What is the relevant date for the inclusion of the paper under the agreement?</p>	<p>The submitted date is the relevant date.</p>

What is the time frame for the inclusion of an article under the agreement?	It takes up to half a year.
How can the publisher's platform for an organization be accessed, and by whom?	The OPEN ACCESS MANAGER of an organization will receive access to the publisher tool to see the submitted/accepted papers for making the eligibility check.
Are reports of OA articles made available?	Yes. It can be seen in the 'Open Access Manager' or provided on request.
What information is available in the report?	The report shows detailed information on the paper / DOI link / journal title / corresponding author name / Co-Authors / affiliations, eligibility status and PDF of the paper.
How are OA article reports delivered? / How can OA article reports be retrieved?	OA article reports can be made available through Publisher, every year.
Do reports show different ways of making a paper Open Access?	Yes, the reports show papers made Open Access under the agreement and also the ones which are made Open Access through a Third Party.
Is it possible to add a Crossref Funder Id?	Yes, please contact subscriptions@scientific.net .
Are articles labelled as OA in the publisher's metadata?	Yes, with CC-BY 4.0 in the metadata and published paper.
Does the publisher deliver / deposit OA articles?	No
Who is the recipient when the publisher delivers / deposits OA articles?	Not applicable. TTP does not deliver to an OA repository.
What interface is used when the publisher delivers / deposits OA articles?	Not applicable.
