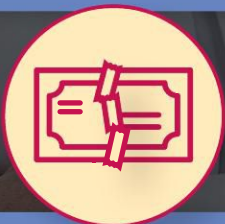

Expanded reach of *Texas Medicine Today*, TMA's daily newsletter, and *Texas Medicine*, TMA's monthly magazine



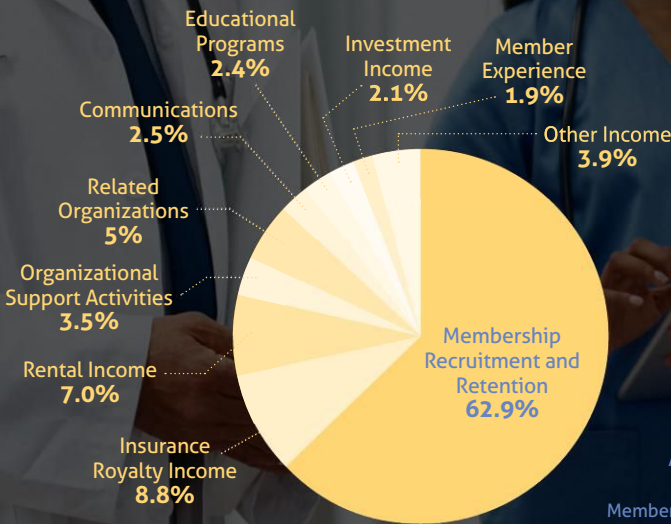
Answered nearly 16,000 calls and emails through TMA's Knowledge Center

Responded to nearly 852 media inquiries

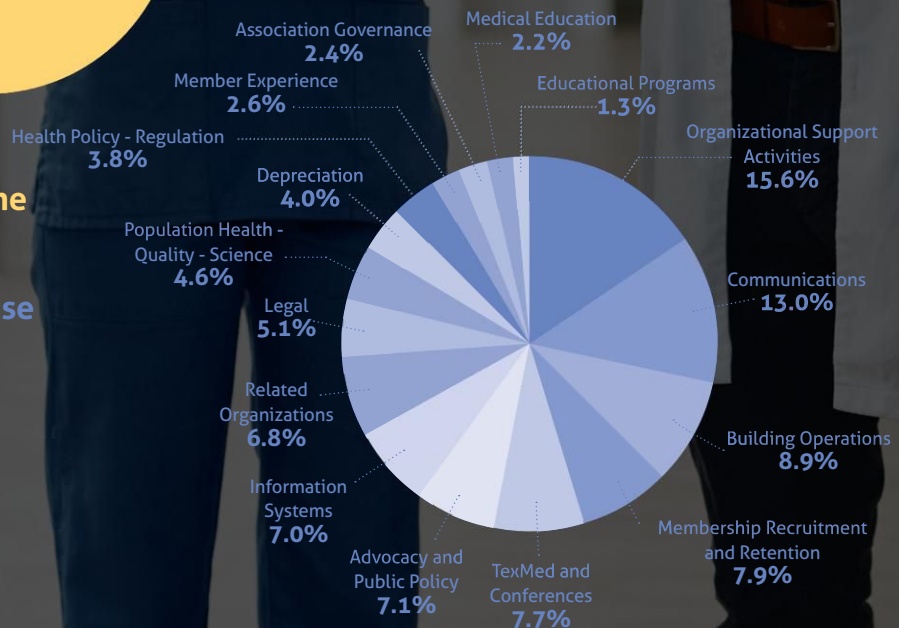
