Chapeau

The General Assembly, in its resolution [73/6](#) of 26 October 2018, noted with appreciation that the preparatory process and the high-level segment of UNISPACE+50 which had resulted in “Space2030” Agenda provided a comprehensive, inclusive and strategically oriented vision on strengthening international cooperation in the exploration and peaceful uses of outer space, in which space was seen as a major driver of and contributor to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals for the benefit of all countries.

Since then, thanks to the effort of United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs (UNOOSA), emerging space startups in Japan and Africa have benefited from its “Access to Space for All” Initiatives increasing the number of space startups activities in Japan (above 85 as recorded in 2023) and Africa (above 70 as recorded in 2023). The establishment of Japan Africa Space Business Network (JASBN) seeks to promote space startup activities in Japan and Africa. (<https://www.jasbn.com>) to strengthen the existing relation between Japan and Africa to utilize space product and services for mutual benefits.

I was honored to be invited by UNOOSA to participate in the World Space Forum 2023 which provides an opportunity to draw attention to space solutions that will effectively support the areas mentioned in the various Policy Briefs leading to the Summit of the Future. In addition, it will provide a set of practical recommendations to maximize the opportunities space solutions offer as input for the Summit of the Future 2024 and the Pact of the Future.

The UNOOSA “Space Bridge” was launched after the World Space Forum 2023 to enhance our capacity-building activities to ensure that space solutions can be scaled where needed to drive transformational change, build resilience, and enhance global sustainability.

JASBN seeks to put forward actionable strategies that address the "how" of integrating space products and services to the five chapters outlined in the Pact for the future.

Chapter I. Sustainable development and financing for development
