Demolition Begins on Wofford and Richardson Residence Halls



Demolition of Wofford Hall began on Aug. 12 as crews began tearing down the more than 50-year-old residence hall located at the corner of Cherry Road and Alumni Drive. Once Wofford is completed, crews will begin tearing down Richardson Hall. The two high-rises have been closed since 2021 due to their age and structural integrity. Donors Generously Give Nearly \$4.6 Million for FY23-24



Winthrop reported a successful year of giving during the 2023-24 fiscal year and saw increased participation by donors, according to the Division of University Advancement. Vice President Kevin Hughes said 2,971 donors gave \$4,596,362 to the institution. The Winthrop Fund, which offers immediate support to students and the university, saw a 15 percent increase in dollars raised during the 2024 fiscal year when compared to the 2023 fiscal year. 
Campus Celebrates Back to School Activities
